We invite you to get your Technician level ham radio license, Morse code is no longer required. You will receive instruction from experienced ham operators, get answers to your questions, see equipment, get advice and network.

Requirements prior to the class: Read two documents, #1-GERC Tech Class (2 pages), #2. Study Guide (42 pages) You should have access to the Internet. AS SOON AS POSSIBLE go to www.neighborhoodlink.com/org/gerc. Download these documents. Print the documents – or burn a disk and take it to Staples or Office Max and have them printed for about \$5.00. Put both documents in a folder or binder – **THEN** go on line to any of the web sites noted on the 2-page document and take the free Technician Test Question Pool. We suggest QRZ.com – <http://www.qrz.com/testing.html> Take the test as many times as you want – pass it as many times as you can. If needed re study the 42 page document. Use this method to prime yourself with information prior to the class – from our experience this works best!

The total cost for everything is \$ 25.00, which includes the mandatory ARRL test fee. You must take the test in person.
