




#### **Home Removal**

Instructions to residents removing home from the Community.

Recently we had a home destroyed by fire. The homeowner

had no insurance and the pull out became a problem.



- 1. The office must be notified in writing, 30 days in advance. At which time you will be given a form to follow and complete.



2. You are responsible for notifying your utility companies of the pull out. The electric, gas, telephone, cable TV and internet must be disconnected. For gas, the meter must be pulled and the pipe removed.



- 3. A City of St. Petersburg permit MUST be pulled.
- 4. A licensed insured contractor must supply the business office with license and insurance coverage proof.



- 5. All concrete must be removed.
- 6. The lot should be totally cleared and leveled.



- 7. No contractors are permitted to work on Saturday or Sunday.
- 8. Lot should be totally cleared and leveled.

For a list of contractors who do this work, please call the business office.

#### **Visitors & Vendors**

Please remember to call the gate when you are expecting a visitor or a vendor.

Even if the visitor is walking or riding a bike they must stop at the gate and tell the guard where they are going.

This is for your safety.

# Scientists Probe The Atmosphere Of An Alien World

Scientists have detected more than 500 planets orbiting distant stars outside our solar system, but figuring out what kind of atmosphere they have has been understandably challenging.

Yahoo News reports that now they have a chance to analyze the atmosphere of one alien planet 40 light-years from Earth.



The planet, GJ 1214b, is a so-called "Super Earth," larger than our home planet but smaller than gas giants like Jupiter and Saturn. Astronomers are able to study its atmosphere because it passes directly in front of its sun as it moves along its orbit. The planet's atmosphere filters the star's light passing through, allowing scientists to identify the elements making up the atmosphere.

So far, the planet appears flat and relatively featureless, with a cloud cover that might contain water vapor. Prospects for extraterrestrial life on GJ 1412b are minimal, though, because the planet appears too warm for liquid water to exist in large quantitie
