Unacceptable Materials: Liquids, chemicals, pesticides, oil, concrete, bricks, soil, sod, commercial waste, food wastes.



Code Compliance Hot Tips: Dial 311

High Weeds & Trash

When grass, weeds or trash is taller than 12" a notice may be issued. The City may clear the lot and bill the owner. Within 1,000 feet of a school or if over 48" tall the City may clear it at the owner's expense without notice. This applies to grass growing on the sidewalk along your property.
