⁹Honor the LORD with your wealth, with first fruits of all your produce; ¹⁰Then will your barns be filled with grain, with new wine your vats will overflow. (Prov 3:9-10)

²⁷Refuse no one the good on which he has a claim when it is in your power to do it for him. ²⁸Say not to your neighbor, "Go, and come again, tomorrow I will give," when you can give at once. (Prov 3:27-28)

³¹He who oppresses the poor blasphemes his Maker, but he who is kind to the needy glorifies him. (Prov 14:31)

¹³He who shuts his ear to the cry of the poor will himself also call and not be heard. (*Prov* 21:13)

We must also be careful not to blaspheme our Lord by oppressing others (*Prov 14:31*).

President's Corner


Dear Brothers and Sisters,
