



Dear Constituents, Friends and Neighbors:

Wow, what an amazing four years! It has been a tremendous ride...full of opportunity, accomplishment and the reality of serving our district and city. Serving you has been the experience of a lifetime that I will forever cherish. I have worked closely with our military, JROTC programs, Boy/Girl Scouts, Eagle Scouts, NEISD and Alamo Heights schools, Morgan's Wonderland, neighborhood leadership, community organizations; and with the greatest respect, I worked hard for YOU.

There are many highs and lows when serving the public. One high, which brings everything into perspective for me, was having the honor of presenting the Bronze Star to WWII hero, Tomas Jimenez. On several sad occasions, I attended the funerals of military heroes and first responders who gave their lives in the line of duty. Our collective service as citizens, elected representatives, and those who protect and serve us makes our country the best in the world.

With your ideas, we initiated many new policies, such as the <u>on-premise digital sign ordinance, dog-friendly dining</u> <u>ordinance, and the Bulverde Road Preservation Corridor Overlay District</u>. Additionally, the Austin 2 line Quiet Zone is fully funded and currently under construction. With your support and that of the City Council, our office was able to complete many initiatives. The following are just a few of the enhancements made to our community:

- Enhanced public safety by working closely with the North SAFFE Office and supporting programs such as Cellular on Patrol and Explorers; council also added 329 new police officers and 160 new fire/EMS positions in the past four years
- **Protected neighborhoods** by rezoning the Northern Hills Golf Course to prevent multi-family development, closed the Headliner's Show Club for illegally operating a gentleman's club and facilitated the El Chaparral Apartment demolition
- **Supported Seniors** by opening the first Multi-Service Senior Center in Northeast San Antonio; purchased six and one-half acres of land for the "City Center Complex" which could house a permanent senior center, WellMed Clinic, government offices, library, Community Link Center and other facilities all in one location
- Addressed environmental concerns by creating the seasonal Household Hazardous Waste drop-off site at the Bitters
  Brush Recycling Center; participated in the Basura Bash waterway clean-up at the Tobin Trailhead and Graffiti Wipeout
  events on an annual basis; secured a commitment for more than 100 acres of future park land in our district
- **Improved communication** between our office and constituents by creating the District 10 email newsletter, San Antonio Community Guide, Coffee with Clamp meetings, and the District 10 Neighborhood Presidents meetings
- Focused on education by creating the District 10 Scholarship Program which awarded 26 scholarships; helped create the "Be One in a Million" library card challenge program and provided needed supplies to our Elementary schools

Additionally, we were able to add the honorary name "TAPS MEMORIAL BLVD" to Harry Wurzbach Road as a tribute to those interred at Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery. A preliminary engineering report, conceptual plan and design study has also been completed for the roadway. The conceptual plan proposes a complete streetscape to include sidewalks, bike lanes, landscaping, lighting and military themed landmarks. The next step in the process to improve Harry Wurzbach is to identify funding options from local, state and federal agencies. Our office was also instrumental in securing \$130 million in funding to complete construction of Wurzbach Parkway.

It has been a privilege to serve the citizens of District 10 for two terms on City Council. Every accomplishment made by our office was only possible because of your support, that of city staff, and our wonderful **District 10 staff - thank you all!** Although I will no longer serve on council, I will continue to be involved in our community and will always look out for your interests.
