Sites will only accept materials that cannot be set out for regular garbage or recyclable collection. *Examples:* broken or unusable bulky items like furniture, mattresses, televisions etc.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE DUMPSTER:

Tires – Appliances – Trees or Yard Waste – Hazardous Materials – Paint, Oil, Herbicides or Commercial waste

Yard Waste (Brush, logs & trees) vouchers (free pass) will be provided at the dump site for River City Recycling, 6404 S. 60th St. but will only be available for use on May 22nd.

Any items in good, clean, and working condition can be donated to **Catnip and Tails Rescue**, a local animal rescue organization that helps numerous homeless and abandoned animals to receive necessary vetting and find adoptive homes.
