## **Update – Four Mile Flood Control Project**

If you normally have water around your house during times of high water, this is for you. Because they are changing the levees, the water must go somewhere, so the low areas in our neighborhood will be in a flood plain. It is recommended you check into getting flood insurance as soon as possible before it becomes impossible for you to do so. Other recommendations are for a flap valve to prevent a sewer backup, putting in a sump pump and possibly evaluating the tiling and drainage around your property.
