Woodgate South Handyman Corner

Woodgate South homes are about 12 years old on average and you should anticipate repairs to keep your home in tip top shape. One item that you may want to consider replacing is the hot water tank. There are several ways to tell when it is time to replace the old hot water heater. It is best if you can take your time and look at many different kinds before you actually have to replace it. It is no fun rushing around trying to find a replacement on a Friday afternoon! But what are the signs the old water heater is ready to retire?

- 1. Age. A gas hot water heater is expected to last 8-12 years and we are close to that if you still have the original equipment in your home.
- 2. Rust colored hot water- do you get tinted water when you open up the hot water tap? This is a real good indication!
- 3. Hot water is not as hot or you run out of hot water under normal circumstances
- 4. Moisture around the base may signal a slow leak
- 5. An ice cold shower
- 6. A flood in the area around the water heater this could be very expensive to mediate even if you don't have a finished basement.
