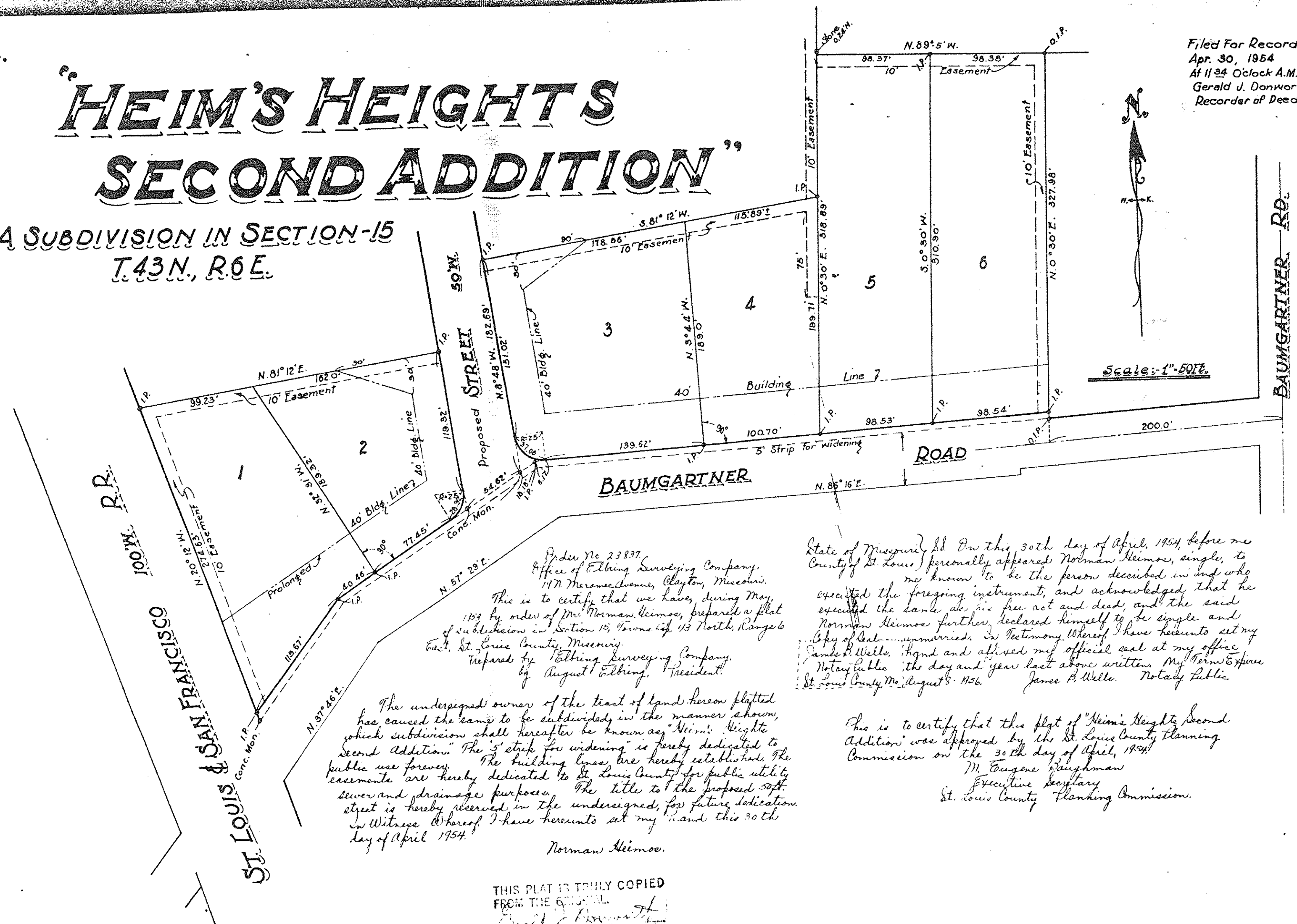


HEIM'S HEIGHTS SECOND ADDITION
