2. Treasurer informed body that she was in receipt of invoices from the President totaling \$209 for printing, supplies and the neighborhood clean-up in May.
 3. Treasurer also presented the 2011 tax assessment for the land that Heritage Valley owns, it was agreed that the treasurer would appeal the value.
- **Crime Update**
 1. APD report was given by Sgt Smith. Unruly children in the neighborhood was addressed and it was stated that the police should be called to combat this issue. He also stated that all tips and concerns are passed along to appropriate individuals in the police department.
 - **Other Reports**
 1. Burned Property on Tollhouse was discussed and residents were encouraged to attend code enforcement hearings in the future. The home should be scheduled for demolition in the next few months.
 2. The following homes have been reported to code enforcement:
 1. 3369 Glenview Circle; whom has several commercial trucks in the yard. Since the report to code enforcement the owner has rectified the violations and the case is closed.
 2. 1840 Glenview Drive and 3544 Mt. Gilead both are still being processed.
 - A neighborhood yard sale was proposed for the third week in July and approved however; the details of the event were tabled until the June meeting.
