I apologize for the short notice, but Rick's Paving notified me today that they would begin repairing our streets next **Tuesday, July 19**, starting as early as 8:00 AM.

In past years, the impact of weather conditions particularly the winter cold, snow, and salt, has been very detrimental to the condition of our streets. We have been seal coating the street, which has only provided a temporary repair to a big problem. We will be using a new process this year to provide a more cost effective and efficient repair of the street with less labor and maintenance over time.

The *Circle Ginny Homeowner's Association* continues to be proactive in keeping our neighborhood a nice and safe place to live.

We will begin Phase I – (1900 – 1914) starting on Tuesday, on the west side of Circle Ginny. We are expected to stay off the street for 24 hours. The street will be blocked with no access on the west side (entrance). It is advised that you park on Burbank Avenue. If it is a necessity to enter or park on the east side, please use extreme caution when entering the one-way street. We anticipate Phase II east side (1916 – 1931) will begin **Thursday, July 21**.

All abandoned cars that are parked on the street will have to be removed as soon as possible. Any cars left on the street Tuesday morning is subject to be towed at the owner's expense.
