PICNIC PERMITS

There are three (3) picnic areas available. We have two picnic areas that hold up to 50 people as well as one that accommodates up to 100. Reservations are required for groups of 10 or more. Check with the office for availability

BASEBALL FIELD

We have one small baseball diamond available for rental. Any team or sports activity will require an official City Permit and insurance including organized pick-up games.

TENNIS COURTS

Tennis courts are available on a first come-first serve basis. Private instruction is not allowed unless the instructor has an official City Permit and proper insurance. (L.A.M.C. 63.44G) Only courts 1, 2 and 3 may be permitted out for instruction. The other three courts (4, 5 and 6) must be available at all times for open play. NO EXCEPTIONS. In order to use Rustic Canyon's tennis courts it is required that the instructor/pro applies for a <u>facility use permit</u> and must provide <u>proof of insurance</u>. (L.A.M.C. 63.44G) Permits are is-sued on month to month bases.

<u>Daily reservations will no longer be given to anyone for instruction.</u> All instructors must follow the permit process. Daily Reservations will only be given for personal play with no more than 4 players on a court at a time.


