Neighborhood Revitalization

The city of Des Moines has a project called Neighborhood Revitalization. We plan to apply for this project. If accepted to this project, we will get help from the city making a <u>long range</u> plan for our area. We need your help.

We will be going door-to-door to get signatures on a petition before **September 16**th. Signing shows that you support our petition and are willing to help if needed.

There have been changes along Four Mile Creek that have remapped part of our neighborhood as a flood plain. Flooding will affect everyone on the East side of Winegardner. It could make it all the way up the street to Valley Circle

Our neighbors may need help with sewer valves, drainage tile and other related items. We want the city's help through manpower and money.

Items we will be asking for:

- 1. Sewer help for flood plain neighbors (ball check valve and/or sump pump)
- 2. Funding from the Neighborhood Finance Corporation. Help buying a home, forgivable loans
- 3. Gazebo by playground with table. Hill needs leveled first
- 4. Park drain by Winegardner. It looks bad. Clean up, renew rocks? Rain garden?
- 5. Sidewalks check and replace
- 6. Mines below research and mitigation
- 7. Vacant house help to get them named as nuisance. Torn down, cleaned up or sold.
- 8. Buyout if needed for flood plain neighbors

You could also help in other ways:

- Consider signing and showing up for the formal presentation on October 12th to the Neighborhood board.
- Write a letter of commitment showing you support for our plan. This could be as simple as saying you are willing to attend meetings or show up to help work if needed.
