Description	Hooch is a yellow brindle with white (tail tip, feet, chest) American Staffordshire Bull Terrier (aka pit bull) with a white muzzle due to age. He is about 11 years old and is believed to have been abandoned by his first owner due to refusing to fight. He is very gentle but terrified of storms and loud noises. Hooch weighs about 46 pounds and is quite athletic. He was wearing a blue nylon collar with plastic buckles, and three tagshis City of San Antonio license, Dodd Animal Hospital rabies vaccination tag, and a Milkbone identification tag. Hooch must have fallen into the front yard when part of the foundation of an enclosed porch that separated the front yard from the back collapsed just as the storm began September 18, and took off running. For this reason, he may have some scratches or injuries that I do not know about. During a storm, he is in a panic and wants to hide. He may have run a long distance in the panic or hidden in the neighborhood. Another dog tracked him twice to the 2100 block of Steves Avenue. He may be in the neighborhood hiding under a garage or in the corner of the yard, still frightened after the storm and the porch collapse. In 10 years, he has never been away from both his home and his owner, and so he may be quite frightened. He tends to be a very friendly and passive dog in normal circumstances. He often barks to get attention and wags his tail simultaneously to greet people.
