In addition to these streetlight issues that are the responsibility of the Illuminating Company, I would like to draw the Village's attention to lighting and other issues that are the Village's responsibility.

Building lights on the Alpha side of the school building at 4000 Washington Park Blvd were on during the day on a sunny day.

Entrance lights to the NHPD at the top of the front steps were on during the day on a sunny day.

The driveway light over the NHFD large bay along Washington Park Blvd was not on at night but the smaller bay lights were.

The pole light above the service department bays off Harvard is not on at night.

The Yield Sign along the bicycle path next to the tree at the NHFD is completely obscured by the tree right before the NHFD driveway.

There are multiple American Flags on display within the Village that are in tatters, faded, not lit at night or otherwise improperly displayed. One is on Village property that is not lit at night. Who would be responsible for contacting individual residents about improper display of the American Flag?

There are multiple street signs throughout the Village that are faded, rusted, bent, improper height, or otherwise in ill repair. Who should be contacted with this list to properly maintain signage?

Much of the road striping needs to be repainted. Of primary concern are the cross walks at Washington Park School and the Harvard and I-77 Bridge and intersections. Who should be contacted about striping the streets and a list of areas to be repainted before it is too cold to do the work?

Guard rails at ends of streets have been in disrepair for years. Rusted, bent, uprooted and unsecured are some of the conditions observed. Who should be contacted to repair these items as well?

Perhaps residents have expressed concerns about the peeling paint on the public services building and the dead trees along the front of the school and Village Hall to council.

These things say a lot about whether or not we respect our own community to keep basic safeguards in good repair. The condition of these things adds to a general appearance of blight and impacts the property values and desirability of our community to those that visit or live here. Please set a positive example with an eye toward public safety by keeping our signage and road markings in decent condition. People are hearing good things about the interior renovations to the NHPD. We look forward to the open house tours.
