





omputers are getting smaller, faster, and less expensive. The cheapest new tablet computer (for now) comes from India. The Aakash ("Sky" in Hindi) is a joint present between HT Poinsthan and of India.

project between IIT Rajasthan, one of India's elite Institutes of Technology, and manufacturer DataWind. Cost: approximately \$49.

The mobile Internet device uses Android technology and is only 7 inches long. It's assembled in India, though its components come from South Korea, China, and the United States (as well as India). 




