Join the Tri-Alliance Security Patrol

What is the Tri-Alliance Security Patrol?

Tri-Alliance is a volunteer-operated neighborhood organization that hires armed, uniformed, off-duty Dallas police officers to patrol the Pebble Creek, Rolling Trails, and Highlands West neighborhoods in marked Dallas police cars. Tri-Alliance is not associated with or funded by any neighborhood association.

Why do we need off-duty police patrols in our area?

On-duty Dallas police officers no longer make routine patrols through our neighborhoods. Instead the Dallas police respond to prioritized 911 calls and are deployed to address specific high crime incident areas.

What do the Tri-Alliance officers accomplish when on patrol in our neighborhoods?

- Patrol streets, alleys, and other common neighborhood areas for visible crime deterrence.
- Respond to 911 calls and residential alarms within minutes.
- Monitor activities at Arbor Park.
- Investigate suspicious people and vehicles.
- Notify members that inadvertently leave open their garage doors.
- Monitor the houses of members when a member is out-of-town.
- Respond to member messages and calls to the patrol officer's cell phone.
- Make traffic stops, issue tickets, and make arrests, as needed.
- Maintain awareness of situations that might negatively affect the safety of our children, families, and visitors.

How does Tri-Alliance operate?

Tri-Alliance collects dues from membership of neighborhood residents and uses the income to pay for patrol time, patrol car rental, and operational expenses. All collections go directly to maintaining and expanding the security patrols. Patrol times and durations are professionally planned within the Tri-Alliance budget by our lead

police officer to maximize effectiveness and efficiency.

How long has Tri-Alliance Security Patrol been in existence?

Tri-Alliance was begun in 1996 by a group of concerned citizens that wanted to make a difference in reducing our neighborhood crime, protecting our residents and their property, and helping to maintain property values. Tri-Alliance is organized as a non-profit corporation to promote the common good and general welfare of our residents.

Why should I join the Tri-Alliance Security Patrol?

By joining Tri-Alliance, you can make a positive difference in the safety and security of our neighborhood. We currently can afford only a few hours daily. More membership means that we can afford more hours of police patrol time. Higher membership levels permit the creation of special holiday patrols during times when our neighborhood residents might be traveling or engaged in holiday activities.

Is Tri-Alliance needed if I already have a security system?

The Dallas police response to a 911 call can require many minutes and depends on the availability and location of the assigned officer. The Dallas police normally dispatch a burglar alarm call on an unoccupied dwelling as a lower-priority call. When on patrol in our neighborhoods, the Tri-Alliance officer can respond to monitored and audible residential alarms and 911 calls from our neighborhoods within minutes from a few blocks away. Also consider that the Tri-

Alliance patrol officer can provide deterrence and law enforcement for areas not covered by a residential or vehicle alarm system.

How do I join Tri-Alliance?

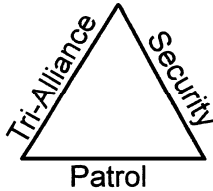
