Accomplishments in 2011:

- Annual street clean on Williams and Dean.
- Neighborhood Signage DONE (Thanks to Member and Sponsor BKM Properties who split the bill
 with us on the signs.) (And to Roger Burdett who helped me re-hang the signs safely out of
 reach of spray cans.)
- Garage Sale Second Saturday in June
- SCRUB DAY: A success, but the last one. City will only do 4/yr in 2012 (one for each quadrant of city), and NE side doesn't get one due to proximity to the transfer station on 3rd Saturday of months. Dump will charge. Don't go there. Harriet will be open for brush
- Park cleaned, painted, new retaining wall in front of swings, and a surround for the park pottie. Thanks Jim's Johns for providing same again this year.

- Thanks to Des Moines Parks Department for the paint, removing the trimmed trees, the expert 1st day help in getting the wall started....but did they have to be 60 lb blocks? No other work anticipated in 2012 unless City moves dirt first. Hopefully level an area for a gazebo
- Master gardner Mary good job! There is a vertical garden at the Botanical Center to go see also. It is in the showhouse.
- Picnic: Moved date due to heat
- Williams/Dean again mowed before the Fair.
- Elections held in Oct: Introduction of board members
- Designated Neighborhood Status: Not secured but.... We got promises. Thanks to all who signed the petitions, and collected signatures (86 of 200 homes signed). City will meet with us to get a plan for the neighborhood. It will help define what is acceptable for us on the farm/flood land
- Holiday Lights Winners names and pictures are on the table (Thanks to Frindley Theaters, Okoboji Grill, and Eastern Buffet, and to Ellyse and Brenda for securing the awards for us!)
- Christmas baskets: 4 delivered, all in the Neighborhood.
- Newsletters: Thanks to all who help!

Ongoing:

- Drainage issues on Williams were supposed to be addressed before winter, but it hasn't
 happened. Harlan will find name and make a call. Dirt washed out so we don't have standing
 water, but now we might have a washout under road
- Flooding issues are continued till sometime in the Spring pending outcome of yet another study of Four Mile. A thought is to use the spillway as flood plain.
 - We are eligible for NFC loans
