


## Bloomingdale Neighborhood Partnering with Wells Street Business Corridor




## Bloomingdale Projects

It was the city's first iron bridge.
It replaced a bridge that was built in 1859.



The Bloomingdale Neighborhood founded in 1974 with the name of Northwest Central.

It was changed to Bloomingdale in 1992.

Bridge looking north


Because our area is so large, the neighborhood has decided instead of one marker on the Wells Street property, we would like to have several markers at our other boundaries.
