These items are acceptable for recycling at the Springfield Materials Recycling Facility (MRF)

Paper (clean, dry and separated from containers):

- Flatten corrugated cardboard (large corrugate cardboard – tied in bundles with string)
- Newspaper & inserts
- Catalogs & magazines
- Paper bags
- Junk mail
- Paperbacks & phone books (covers removed)
- Boxboard (cereal, shoe, cracker boxes, etc.)
- White & color office paper
- Computer paper

Containers (separate from paper recycling):

- Glass bottles & jars - all colors
- Aluminum, tin/steel cans & lids, aluminum foil products
- Milk/juice cartons & drink boxes
- Plastic bottles, jars & tubs – must be less than 2 gallon containers

What you should – NOT – recycle with your paper:

- Soda or beer holders/cartons
- Pizza boxes, egg cartons or wrapping paper
- Waxed paper or waxed cardboard boxes

What you should – NOT – recycle with containers:

- Plastic bags
- Plastic trays, plastic clamshell deli containers
- Prescription pill bottles
- Laundry baskets or recycling bins
- Any plastic container over 5 gallons (no 5 gallon pails)
- Light bulbs, pyrex, window glass, dishes, ceramics, broken glass
- Plastic flowerpots
- Paint or aerosol cans
- Plastic toys
- Bottles that contained motor oil, antifreeze, pesticides or poisonous/hazardous materials
- VCR/CD cases
- Frozen food packaging

For Residents with Municipal Trash Collection



Curbside Collection Information

Paper

Place in Paper Bag

- Newspapers/inserts
- Magazines, catalogs
- Phone books, junk mail
- Office paper
- Paperboard (cereal, cracker boxes)
- Corrugated cardboard, flatten
- Brown paper bags
- Shredded paper in paper bags, not plastic
- **NO** plastic bags or pizza boxes

Containers

Place in Bin

- Glass bottles/jars, all colors & sizes
- Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids
- Aluminum foil/pie plates
- All plastic containers labeled
- Milk cartons and juice boxes
- **NO** cans or bottles containing paint, or hazardous materials
- window glass, dishes, Pyrex, or ceramics
- **NO** plastic bags
- **NO** metal items

Drop-Off/Special Collections

Large Appliances

- 1 of each appliance per year
- Remove doors
- By permit only

Household

- Furniture, clean clothing
- Household items, books
- Building materials

Christmas Trees

- (curbside & drop-off)
- Remove tinsel, twine, ornaments
- Collection 1st 2 weeks of Jan.

Electronics

- TVs, computers

Auto Items

- Tires, Car batteries, motor oil

Paint Items

- Oil based paint, stain and varnish, Hazardous waste collection day only
- Other paint products, Mon.-Fri.

Yard Waste (curbside & drop-off)

- Place in barrel or paper leaf bags
- Leaves, grass, other easily raked materials
- **NO** plastic bags or stumps

Bulk Items

- Large metal items
- Tires, on or off the rim
- Mon.-Fri.

Curbside Recycling Collection Schedule

Recycling is collected every other week on your regular trash day. Mon.-Fri.
Blue week residents have their recycling collected on weeks shaded in blue.
Green week residents have their recycling collected on weeks shaded in green.

Holiday Schedule

When a scheduled collection day falls on a holiday, that day's collection and all remaining collections for the week will be delayed one day (see calendar).
Friday's collection will be on Saturday. Holidays are circled.

Drop-Off Recycling

Recycling Drop-off Center, 63 North Canal Street. Paper and containers also collected at Recycling Drop-off Center.
