  - Fingerprint evidence does take time to process and identify, sometimes weeks
  - Suspects spotted in more recent incident with ski masks
- Sexual assault on 1100 block of Rodney (pa avenue) on 1/4
- Update on Shooting near Bayard: no new information for public release
  - 100 block of S DuPont (between tulip and chestnut)
- Barber Shop at Union and Elm is producing more loitering recently
- Pitbulls at Kosciusko park becoming a problem, city program with SPCA halted due to SPCA space limitations
- Radar sweeping at Lincoln street has had positive resident response. Please let the city know
  if you would like that program to continue (Lt. Ciatti or Cpl. Deets)
