Co-sponsored by The Woodlawn Heights Taxpayers Association and Friends of The Woodlawn Cemetery, several issues were addressed, among them the increase in crime

correlating with the shortage of police officers; condition of our ball fields; the impact of the homeless shelter, etc. While no solutions were presented at the meeting, the Mayor and Commissioners who were present, did have the chance to hear our concerns in person.
