

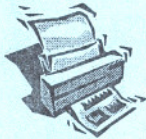


CODE ENFORCEMENT FAQs:

1. How can I report a code violation?

You may report a code violation by one of four ways:

1. Send in a written complaint to CCPRO Box 551716 LVNV 89155-1716
2. E-mail via Clark County Website www.accessclarkcounty.com. Go to county services and click on the A-D tab. Click on code enforcement. Scroll down to "online complaint form" and click to fill out the online form and submit.
- 3 Telephone (455-4191) leave details of the complaint on the message machine.
4. Via fax (455-2080) provide details of the complaint on faxed page.



2. Can I park a vehicle in the front or side yard?

Yes, you may park your vehicle in the front or side yard if it can start immediately and is parked on a paved surface and in an area intended for parking and not blocking the sidewalk. Vehicles cannot be parked on any landscaped area including rock, or the lawn or grass.

3. How many vehicles, trailers and boats may be kept on a single-family residential lot?

Two (2) vehicles may be stored provided they can start immediately but they must be parked on a paved surface and in an area intended for parking and not blocking the sidewalk. Landscape parking is not allowed including rock or the lawn or grass.

4. Can I keep a vehicle that is inoperable or missing parts?

Yes, if it is parked in an enclosed structure such as garage.

5. Are semi trucks allowed to park on the street?

Absolutely not. Commercial vehicles (vehicles over 8500 lbs GVW) may not be parked or stored in a residential zoned area.

6. Where can a vehicle be parked while being repaired or restored?

Unless it is an emergency or minor repair (inflate tires, air filter change, etc.) they need to be parked in an enclosed structure such as a garage. You can only do these minor repairs on your **own** vehicles.

7 Can I display my vehicle for sale in an empty lot? The street?

No to both questions. No vehicle may be displayed "For Sale" on an empty/unimproved lot (enforced by Code Enforcement CC 12.36.020 or Metropolitan Police) or on the street (enforced by Metropolitan Police and the Constable's Office 455-TOWS which is 455-8697).

8 Can I park/store a vehicle in the street?

Yes, for 72 hours provided it is operable and it is currently registered. You cannot store vehicles on the street. Moving them across the street or moving them a few feet to get around this rule is not acceptable.

9 Can a business be conducted from a residence?

Yes, it is very restricted and requires a home occupation license. You must apply through Clark County Business License to begin the approval process.

10. Graffiti...who do I report this to and do I need to give written permission to have it cleaned up?

Citizens call the Graffiti hot line to report Graffiti (455-4509).
Yes, written permission is required to remove graffiti on private property.

11 What is the code on high/overgrown weeds and dead vegetation?

Dry Brush and Weeds over 4" high are prohibited. 30.44.010 (b)(7)(E)
