

Park Vandalism Found 8-11-12

Police responded to a resident's call to report people trespassing in the park Saturday morning around 2:00am. The reporting resident said he saw at least 1 person was arrested. Later that morning I found the broken glass pictured below on top of one of the park tables and small shards of glass all over the floor under the gazebo. While sweeping it up a Rembrandt resident came to the park to retrieve a pair of sunglasses left on the table and he informed me he and a friend had seen the people at the park after 2:00am smoking what he called a "hookah" and described it as a glass water pipe. The resident said he left before the Police got there and the "hookah" was intact but after seeing the glass I was sweeping up he confirmed it was the "hookah". All the pictures below have been forwarded to our Neighborhood Watch Police Team for further investigation.
