


Our web site is humming along nicely and we continue to see more people searching and reaching out to us on Facebook.

Letter From The Manager

- The Mt. Piney laundry vent system was upsized from 4" to 8" duct work. This will give it a better air flow and a better drying time.
- Smith Fence repaired our white fence along Mt Piney. Due to all the wind and rain over the last few months, we needed to reset about 5 posts.
- Several of the old (15 years) corroded well pipes were replaced with galvanized pipes.
- A newer maintenance truck was purchased. It's a 2010 Ford F-150 with an extended bed with only
- 32,000 miles and a 4 year extended warranty.
- Modified incident reports to include non-emergency maintenance requests are available in the office lobby.
- A commercial popcorn machine was purchased for movie night and any other committee that may have a use for it. It has a set of laminated directions that must be followed, so please use with caution.
- A Special Board Meeting was held on Tuesday, July 31st, 2012. A new auditor, Lorri Kidder, of Carr, Riggs & Ingram was selected.
- Even though our precinct number changed from 183 to 153, we will continue to be a polling place for the upcoming November 6th election. Our machines will need to be in place and secured the day before. So the clubhouse will be closed on Monday evening, November 5, 2012.
- Due to uncomfortable conditions at the Mt. Piney laundry, an 18,000 BTU air conditioner was purchased, along with an automatic door closer. This will help with our big mosquito problem as well.
- Also at the Mt. Piney laundry, our floor got a face lift with moss green concrete floor paint.
- After discussions about giving the Atrium a new look, 2 bids have been received to have the Atrium repainted.










ktoberfest is an exclusively German festival. It was, and is, after all, a holiday that honors the marriage of Prince Ludwig, later to become King Ludwig I, and Princess Therese Heldburghauser, in October of 1810. The prince wanted the locals to enjoy the celebration, so he concocted this day-long affair in a meadow outside the town of Munich, named the meadow "Therese's Meadow", and set up hoards and hoards of food, drink, and strolling minstrels, and then, he added a huge horse race to entertain the royalty and the crowds after the wedding ceremony. Many, if not most, of the male German attendees wear Lederhosen and the women don Drindle dresses--the traditional garb of Bavaria. Visitors often wear hats that boast a tuft of goat's hair. Today's Oktoberfest has spread all over the globe. And an Oktoberfest is one mighty-fine party of: music, and beer; dancing, and beer; German dishes of pork and sauerkraut, and beer; and delightful desserts of Black Forest cake or Apple Struddle, and beer. But, why do we celebrate this very, very German holiday in the US of A? Now, THAT is a very dumb question, indeed!

On top of stove: Saute - 1 Medium Eggplant cut into cubes.

(First take some of the skin off in strips.) Use minimum amount of olive oil.

Add: 1 chopped onion

Add: 1 green pepper chopped

Add 1 small can tomato sauce and 1/2 c V-8 juice

Stir together and add:

1 tsp oregano

1/4 tsp garlic powder

1/2 tsp salt

Heat through, then LAYER in baking dish with 1 cup grated cheese. (I use bag of three cheeses grated)

Bake 325 for 45 minutes with lid on. Then increase to

350 - sprinkle more cheese on top and bake 15 minutes longer with the lid off. I have sprinkled bread crumbs with the final layer of cheese also.


