Every two years, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development requires the Long Beach Continuum of Care to conduct a citywide homeless count.

Get involved! Learn about homelessness; survey individuals on the street, meet new people and learn about the resources in your community. You can make a difference!

Over 300 community volunteers are needed to complete this process and your participation is critical for the success of this effort! You can contribute in a variety of ways:

<u>Community Outreach:</u> Recruit volunteers for the count get the word out through flyers and social media. Host donation drives to collect items such as socks, travel size hygiene products and pre-packaged snacks.
