



Letter From The Manager

Dear Residents,

would like to thank everyone who donated their time and energy in making our Founder's Day Picnic a huge success. It was a beautiful sunny day, with good food, music and great company! Thanks for coming out!

Here's what's going on at The Cove.....

- Bellamy's Gas Company made pilot outage repairs on our stove and oven.
 They cleaned and installed a new thermocouple.
- Our audit report was completed and mailed to all shareholders on March 26, 2013.
- TECO Gas Company found that an underground gas meter at Mt Piney laundry needed repiping from the meter to the tankless heater. It was replaced by Tankless of Tampa Bay Company.
 - Additional pool restroom signs were added to both outside entrances for more clarification.
 - ABCO Concrete bid was approved and work has started on the corner of Mt Piney and Mt Arlington. Due to irrigation lines running across and along Americana Drive and Mt Piney, we are cancelling the sidewalk project in front of the office.
 - We are accepting proposals for all of our lawns to be sprayed by a commercial vendor. We will have four applications this year.
 - Matthews Lawn Service has been working on all of the projects that were mentioned earlier and approved.
 - The oleanders were removed and replaced with Indian Hawthorne. Seeding of lots continues, along with replacing several trees.
 - Smith Fence has installed our new walkway railing at the Atrium.
 - Water restrictions are still in place and must be observed. Even numbered homes can water on Saturdays, and odd numbered homes can water on Sundays. The watering hours are 5 9 am or 7 11 pm.
 - Three new signs were installed from the Sign-A-Rama Company. These included our new street map directional sign at the guard house, the activity sign across from the main entrance, and our Founder's Day Memorial sign.

Carol Risley, Vice President, also worked on the By-Laws Committee and was responsible for scheduling use of the ACA facilities as well as maintaining the supply inventory and keeping our shelves stocked. I would also like to thank Sandie Reid for her work as editor of the Forecaster and helping to maintain the master calendar of events. There were a myriad of residents who voluntarily came forward and offered their time to make our luncheons, functions, and events successful. These volunteers have greatly enlarged our circle of friends. Over the course of the past year, Susie and I have developed many new and, I know, lasting friendships.







To all of you leaving us for the summer, have a safe trip. I look forward to seeing you return in the fall of this year!





Why is Internet traffic so important to home sales?

It is so important because 90% of home buyers look on the Internet first when searching for homes. This information was announced by the National Association of Realtors (NAR) in a study with Google that was released in January.

What is the MLS or Multiple Listing Service and how does it work?

Every county in Florida has a county-wide real estate organization that represents real estate professionals. Each county either has its own MLS or has joined together with other counties



to have a service that covers a wider area. The Pinellas County Realtors Association has joined with other surrounding counties to host a service that covers from Orlando to Sarasota. Therefore, all homes for sale with Barefoot Realty in Americana Cove that have a share attached are listed on the MLS. Your homes marketed by our company are shown to Realtors® in every county throughout central Florida. A real estate salesperson must be a dues-paying member of the Pinellas County Realtors Association to be able to access the MLS. Although a real estate salesperson must be a member of a local association to sell homes, they do have a choice as to whether to join the MLS or not. There is a difference; so don't assume that your real estate salesperson is on the MLS. Be sure to ask. All Realtors® with Barefoot Realty are members and can list homes on the MLS.

Once the property is on the MLS, it is automatically placed on realtor. com, which is the National Association of Realtors website that is the first site that home buyers turn to when looking for real property. The second most popular site for searching for homes is Trulia, according to the joint study by the NAR and Google. Therefore, even the homes on rented lots are being viewed by the second most popular real estate website.


