# Mail Delivery From our AMCOVE



an Olney spoke with the Post Master on Gandy Blvd regarding information on the upcoming changes to our mail delivery. The Post Master did reiterate this is not a choice, it must be done. The discussions with Americana Cove have been handled through the district office however; she was able to provide the information below:



LETTER CARRIER



1. We are limited to only two stations, possibly three. The locations are yet to be determined.



2. There is funding available for those entities who have stations installed this year however, once the funds are gone, they are gone. Hence, the sooner we do this the better otherwise we will be financially responsible. The cost is over \$30,000.



3. There will be no need to change your mailing address to a box number.



4. Two, possibly three keys are issued for each mail box. If you sell your home, relocate, or move away, you may give your mail box keys to the new owner. If keys are lost, you will be responsible to pay a \$25.00 fee for lock replacement. You cannot have additional keys made if you lose them. This type of key is protected and may not to be duplicated.



5. Packages are placed in a larger parcel post box near your mailbox. You are provided a key for access to this box. The key is retained in the lock when you retrieve your package and the mail carrier removes the key. Larger boxes, as well as certified mail will be delivered to your door.



6. Hardship delivery is available by request to the post office. This must be accompanied with documentation from your physician; along with certification that no other family members are available to retrieve mail on your behalf.



7. If at any time your mailbox is full, further mail will be held at the post office for retrieval upon your return. ....continued on page 19





8. It is an option for the Cove to handle the delivery of keys to homeowners. Keys would be held at the office in sealed envelopes. This in turn would allow seasonal residents the option of having someone else obtain keys for them. We would of course require something in writing granting this permission.

Hopefully this answers some of your concerns. Obviously, there is much to be done to accomplish this task and we do not have all the answers at this time. The Board will communicate details to all residents as we move forward with this process.

# Needle Disposal From our AMCOVE



ome residents have been putting syringes and needles in the

garbage. Our men have to handle the garbage and are in danger of getting pricked by a needle. Needles have to be disposed of properly.

#### Florida Household Sharps Disposal

To minimize risks from improper disposal of home-generated needles, syringes with needles, diagnostic lancets, etc., many Florida counties have implemented programs that provide accessible and affordable methods to dispose of this type of waste in a safe manner. These programs provide strategically located sites where residents can drop off a container filled with needles and at many sites receive a new container at minimal or no cost.

If your county health department or local county government does not have this type of program, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has several possible options for safe needle disposal.

A United States Post Office list in the Florida web site also provides approved biomedical waste mail-in services. Needles, syringes with needles, diagnostic lancets, etc., are placed into containers provided by these services and mailed to a facility for treatment. As a last resort, if the options above are not feasible, the Florida Department of Health and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection recommend individuals follow the guidelines on page 20. ....continued on page 20

#### **Needle Disposal**



• If you use this last-resort option, make sure to check first with your local garbage company and your local landfill to make sure these disposal procedures are allowed in your county.



• If your county allows this last-resort option, place needles, syringes with needles, lancets, and other sharp objects into a hard-plastic or metal container with a screw-on top or other tightly fitting lid (i.e., an empty liquid-detergent bottle or paint can).



• Before the container is full all the way to the top, put on the top or lid and tape it on with heavy-duty tape.



• Put the container in the center of your trash when you throw it out.



• Do not put needles and other sharp objects in any container you plan to recycle.



• Do not use clear-plastic or glass containers.





• Do not throw loose or unprotected needles into your garbage.





## **Human Brain Cells Enhance Learning In Mice**

e know a little bit more about how the human brain works, thanks to experiments with human brain cells grafted onto the brain cells of mice. Scientific American reports that a group of neuroscientists took a type of brain cells called glia and injected them into the brains of newborn mice (under anesthesia). The glia matured into astrocytes, which facilitate high-speed connections within the brain.

In the mice, the human astrocytes increased the strength of synaptic signals between neurons, enhancing the mice's ability to learn. The results may suggest a path toward between understanding of how to treat neurological and psychiatric disorders, scientists say.


