We Remember Our Neighbor and Friend

Evie Lee Edmond, daughter to Lena Mae Neal Forte and Sterling Green Forte, was born on February 14, 1935 in New Boston, Texas. She professed her faith in Christ at an early age. She was a member of United Methodist Church in Windcrest, Texas until her death. Evie passed away peacefully at home on June 16th, 2013 at the blessed age of 78. She joined her parents, Green Sterling Forte and Lena Mae Neal Forte and her brother Roy Lee Forte in Heaven. In 1948 Evie met her soul mate, her beloved husband Charles Edmond in Ogden, Utah; they were married August 9th 1953, at Fort Benning, Georgia. To this union four children were born. Evie received her early education in Idabel, Oklahoma and received her nursing degree at Langston University. She worked as a nurse at the army base in Camp Zama Japan during the Vietnam War. She then moved to San Antonio in the early 70s and worked for General Electric. She attended Southwest Texas State University and received her Bachelor's Degree in Business and Marketing. Evie then went on to be an Aerospace Engineer at Kelly Air Force Base, where she later retired. She was an active member of Phi Delta Kappa and the Top Ladies of Distinction.
