TUMAMOC LANDFILL RESTORATION PROJECT

The old landfill on the South west side of Tumamoc will be cleaned up! The landfill was used between 1964 and 1966, near Starr Pass and La Cholla Blvd. Funds from the Bond election of 2008 were used to purchase a 320-acre parcel of Tumamoc Hill which includes the landfill. Beginning in May 2013, the landfill will be capped with soil and methane gas and groundwater monitoring will continue. The site will be seeded with native seeds to prevent growth of bufflegrass on the site. Work should be complete this fall.

SENTINEL PARK CELEBRATION HELD

August 8th 2013 marked a sunset ribbon-cutting ceremony for all of the improvements made to Sentinel Peak Park (aka A-Mountain) in the past year. Funded by HURF highway funds, the park now sports new restored trails, overlooks, wheelchair access and other amenities. Sentinel Peak Park is also up for \$2.5 million in County Bonds to further preserve and improve this Tucson icon. The signs at the base of Cuesta are also part of improvements completed recently.
