

## Worthington Book Club Questions and Answers

Q. What kind of books are allowed?

A. Any genre of books are allowed as agreed upon by the members: fiction, non-fiction, poetry, short stories and long stories are all welcome.

Q. How often do you meet?

A. Monthly on a Saturday. Dates and times TBA (If you are not part of the distribution list, you can check on [www.worthingtonhoa.com](http://www.worthingtonhoa.com) under Worthington Book Club News for dates and times - you must log in).

Q. Who selects book of the month?

A. The book of the month will be determined by whomever is hosting the discussion for that month. Initially, names were drawn to decide the order (below). And new members will be added to the list.

Q. Where will the discussions take place?

A. The host for the month will determine the place for the meeting - whether a restaurant or the host's home. It was determined at the initial meeting that if a host held the discussion in-house, the other members would bring a dish (potluck).

Q. How long are the meetings?

A. Undetermined. The initial meeting did not set up a time allowance.

Q. What if there are differences of opinion?

A. Differences of opinion are expected. Members will be respectful of others opinion. We all may gain some insight and clarity or see something different from another's point of view.

Q. How do you keep track of books read and discussions?

A. The Worthington Book Club is on the Goodreads website. The monthly host can log in and post the book of the month, discussion highlights, member opinions and any other informative information. This is a good mechanism for members as well as new members who want to remember or know what books were read and the members perceptions and discussions.

Q. What if you do not complete the book?

A. All are welcome, even if you do not complete the book.

Q. Can you bring guests?

A. Of course; however, please notify the host so that adjustments can be made for food prep or restaurant reservations.
