

Did you know?

Councilwoman Marianne Butler in partnership with Olmsted Parks Conservancy and Louisville Metro Parks & Recreation are preparing for a \$1 million project at Iroquois Park's Northern Overlook. The project seeks to enhance the overlook improving by its sustainability, make it less prone to erosion, and create a vibrant and welcoming public space. The first stage of the Northern Overlook Restoration Project is underway, with Metro Parks crews removing concrete, existing paving stonework at the site. A design plan, expected to be completed by the end of summer, will be developed with public input through a series of meetings. Some initial construction may take place by the end of the year. The Northern Overlook and the Corbly Trail will be closed to public use and the overlook will be vehicular closed to traffic indefinitely as the project progresses.
