- **1. Welcome**, Opening and Introductions. The meeting opened about 610 P.M. and those present introduced her/himself. The 4 December 2013 NWNA minutes were approved, and the October minutes were not available. (The NWNA did not meet in January 2014 because the first Wednesday was New Year's Day.)
- **2. TPD report.** Two officers were present. Crime statistics were discussed. Other related discussion occurred.
- **3. D.R. Liggins Center/Birdman CTR report.** Mike Katherina reported that A.J. Rico is the new supervisor and Terry Nierzwicki is the new reservations person. Enhance Fitness program for seniors, and Rodeo SchoolzOut Camp were discussed.
- **4. Ward III report.** Judith presented a handout from W3NA, 15 Jan 2014, Ward III Transportation Projects. There was discussion on the estimated \$33.4 million deficit in the City budget for FY 2014-2015.

5. NWNA committee items needing possible action - motions made, debated, yes/no pass, and, or, tabled.

- 5-a. Treasurer's Report. Carolyn is not present. Per James K, same as December 2013, i.e., \$1433 consolidated account (\$55 general and \$1378 in the C2E restricted funds.) The interim report was approved. 5-b. Annual UA Mortar Board Clean Up Event, Sa, 29 March 2014. Armando reported that our neighborhood will participate in three tasks (pending confirmation), a tri-neighborhood graffiti abatement, greenway between Elm and Lee Streets, and the 5th AV easement between Linden and Waverly.
- 5-c. Annual 4th AV tree pruning. There was a consensus to prune these trees, especially the ones at the NW corner of 4th AV/Lester ST, either Sa, 22 February or Sa, 1 March, between 10 A.M. and 1 P.M. Pending confirmation of two roll offs. Armando will reserve the roll offs.
- 5-d. C2E grant project. Dan presented information. There was discussion on the collective process and collective products, i.e., were both processes fair and participatory as possible. Opinions differed. The bineighborhood (EC and NW) planning group decided 9 yea and 1 nay to proceed with the project.

This project is being handled by the City-DOT, Gary Wittwer is the liaison.
