Easy Ways to Report It

Graffiti is a crime.

Neglect graffiti and it
attracts more graffiti.

Here are ways you can
help to keep
our community
free of graffiti.







Graffiti is vandalism. It appears as words, pictures or symbols applied to any surface – without the consent of the property owner, authorized agent or designee. Graffiti costs taxpayers money, devalues property, and undermines perceptions about safety. Remove graffiti within 24 hours and you help to eliminate the attention that taggers seek.

Work with neighbors, your neighborhood association or homeowners' association to be the eyes and ears for your community to keep it graffiti free.

When you make contact, provide the address or cross streets with a description of where the graffiti is located.

Commercial property owners and homeowners are responsible for removing graffiti on buildings or areas within their property. Home improvement and hardware stores carry several different graffiti removal products. Removing graffiti yourself? Take photos of the graffiti; note the location, date and time; and estimate the square footage cost to clean it up. Call 520-791-5843 for information.
