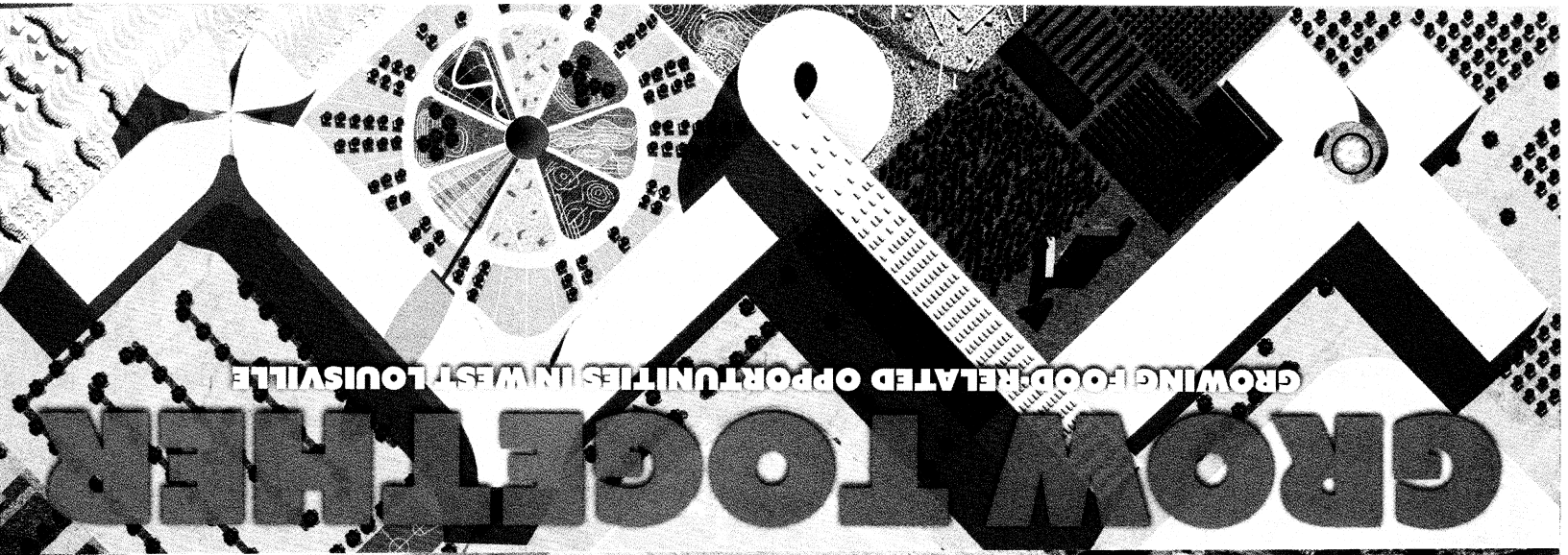
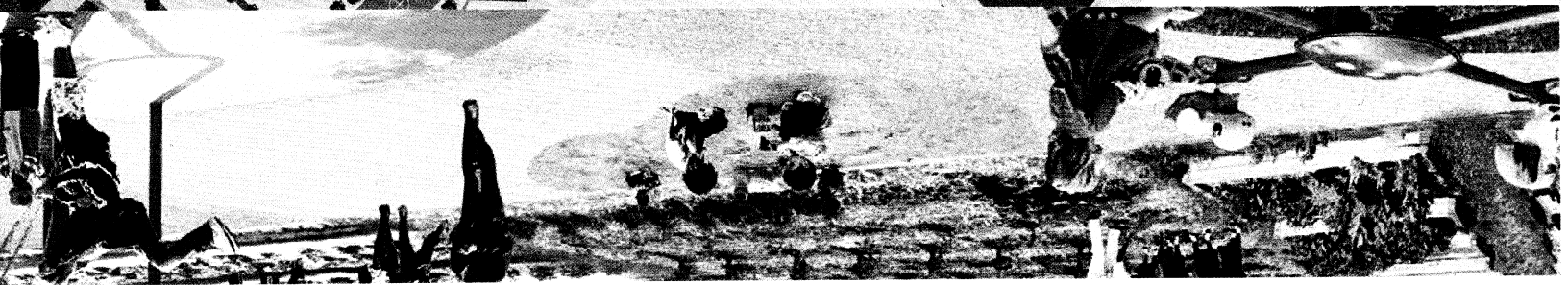




CONNECTING OUR CITY
