Background On Survey Process

- ▶ We utilized a nationally tested community resident perception survey
- ▶ Teamed up with graduate and undergraduate interns from the UA
- ▶ Knocked on 1,100 doors
- ▶ Talked with 350 residents in person
- ▶ 150 residents took a survey in person
- ▶ 10 residents responded by mail

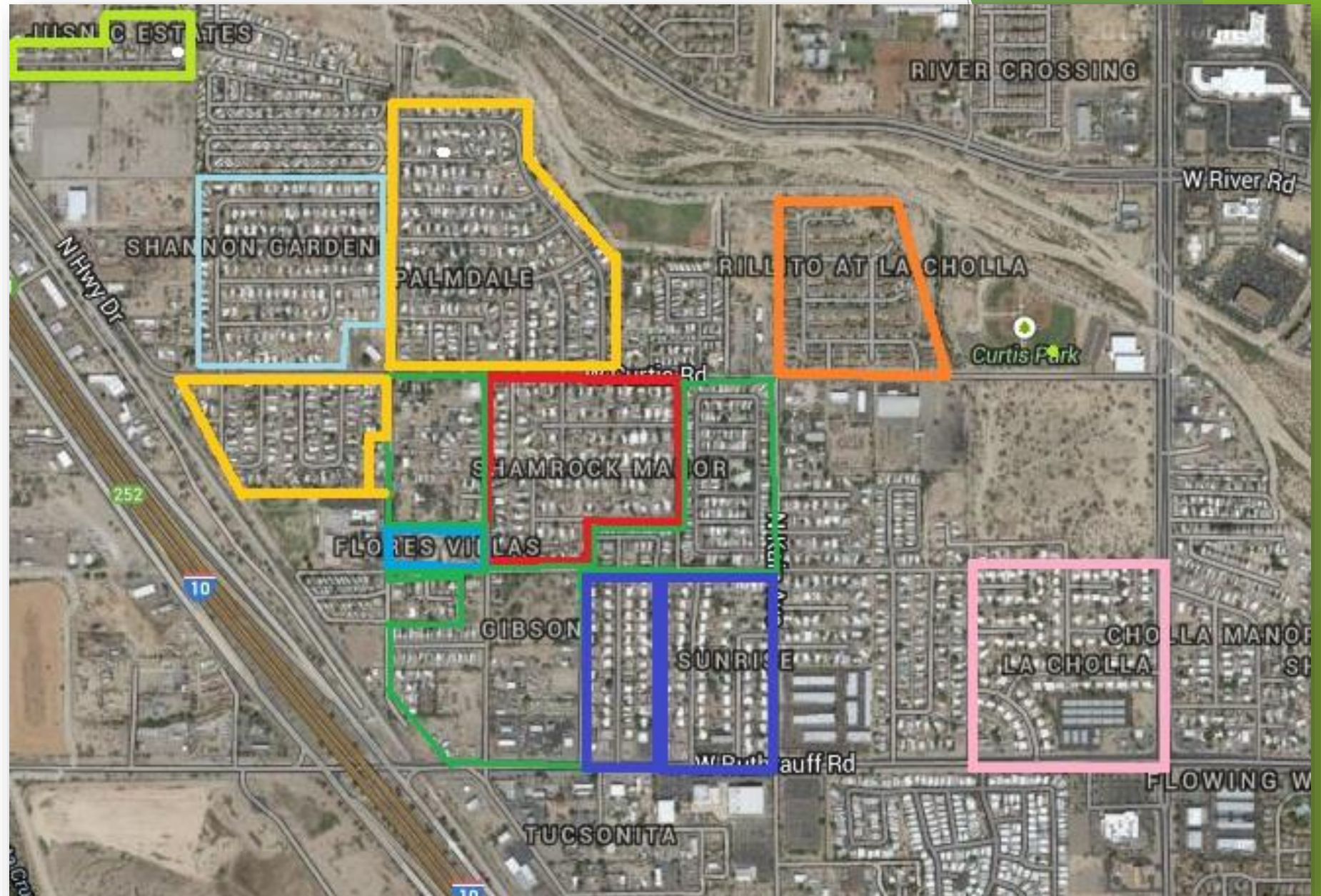

We surveyed the area in sections.

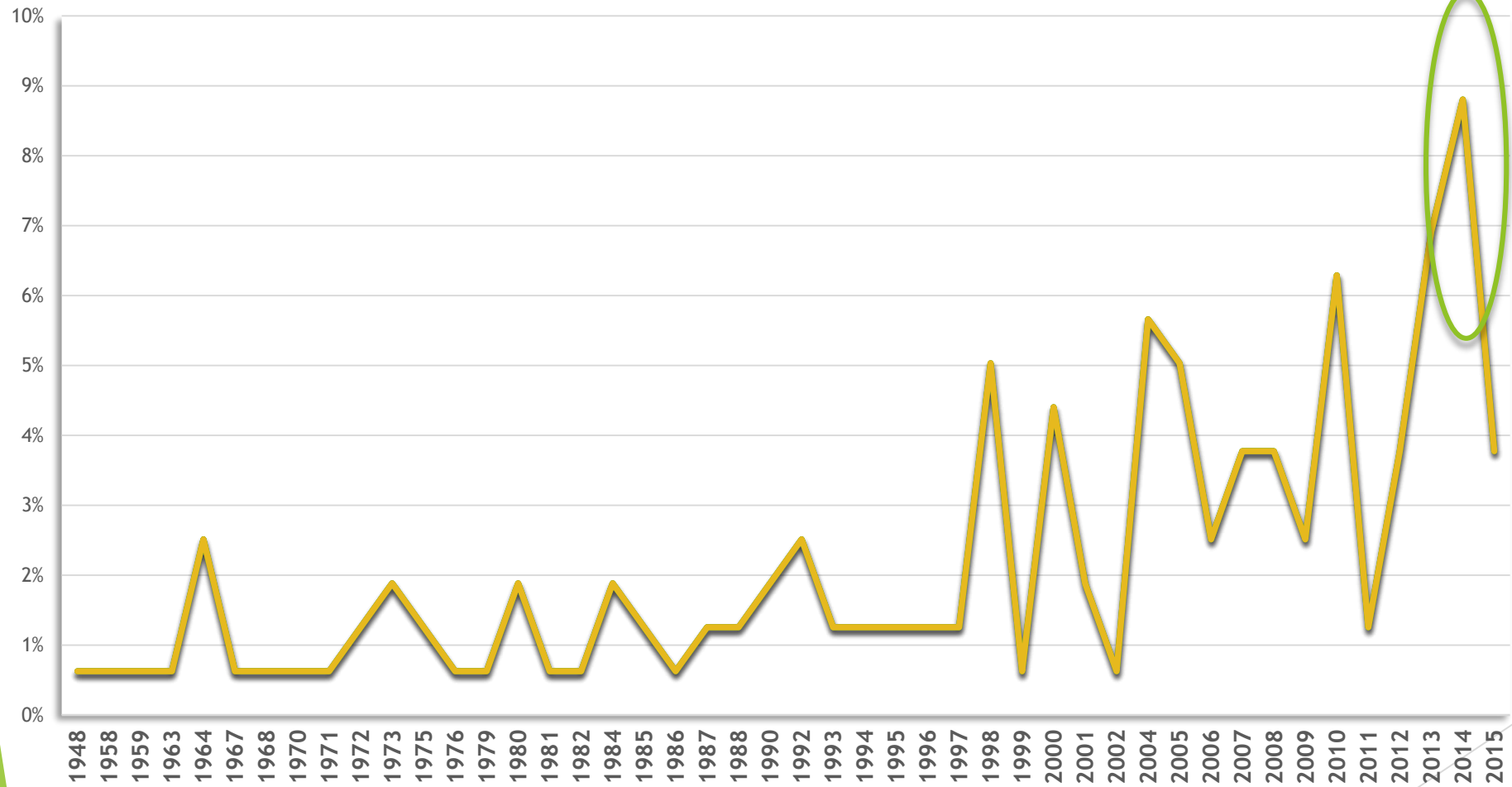
To the right is an example of how we divided some of the area up.



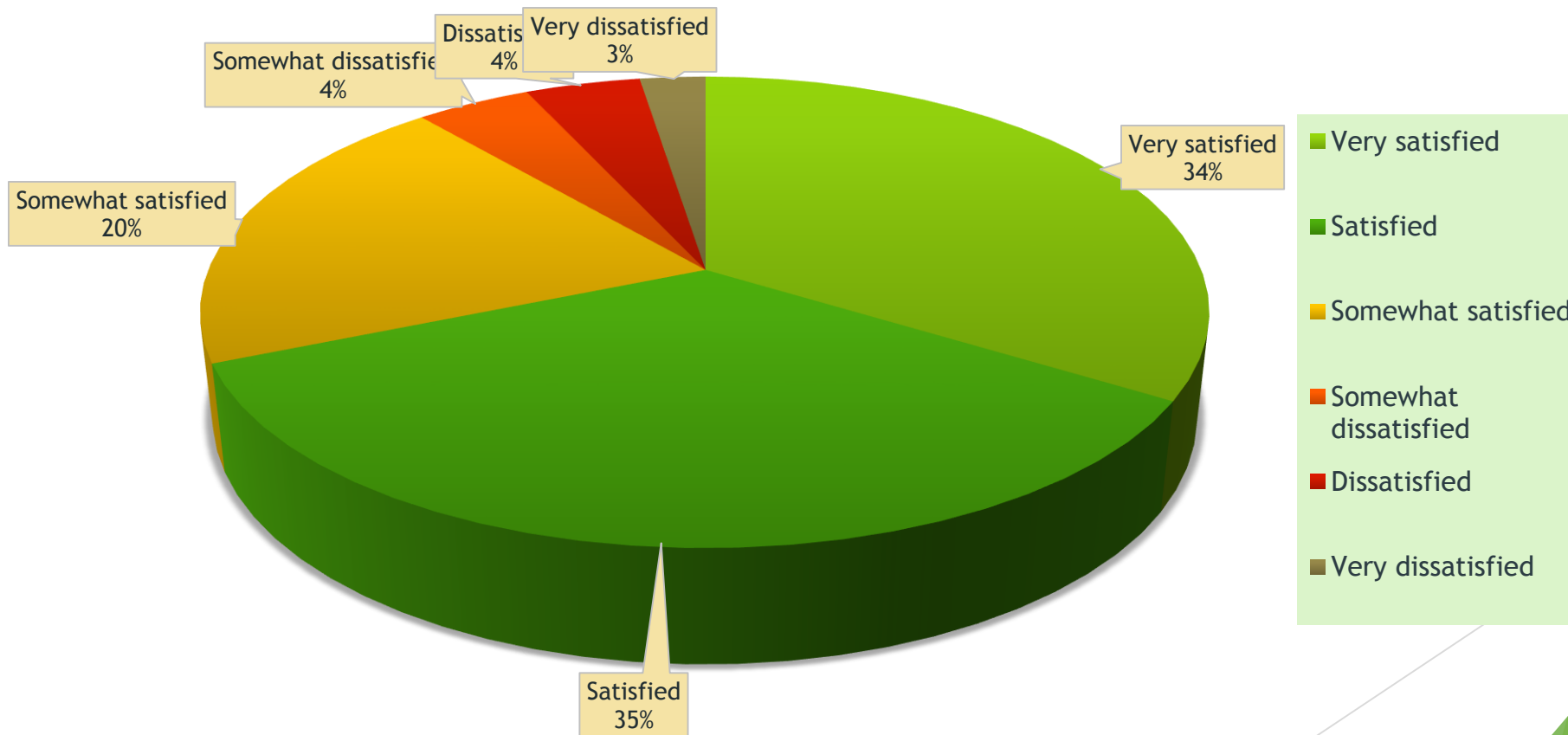
What Residents Told Us About Flowing Wells Neighborhood...

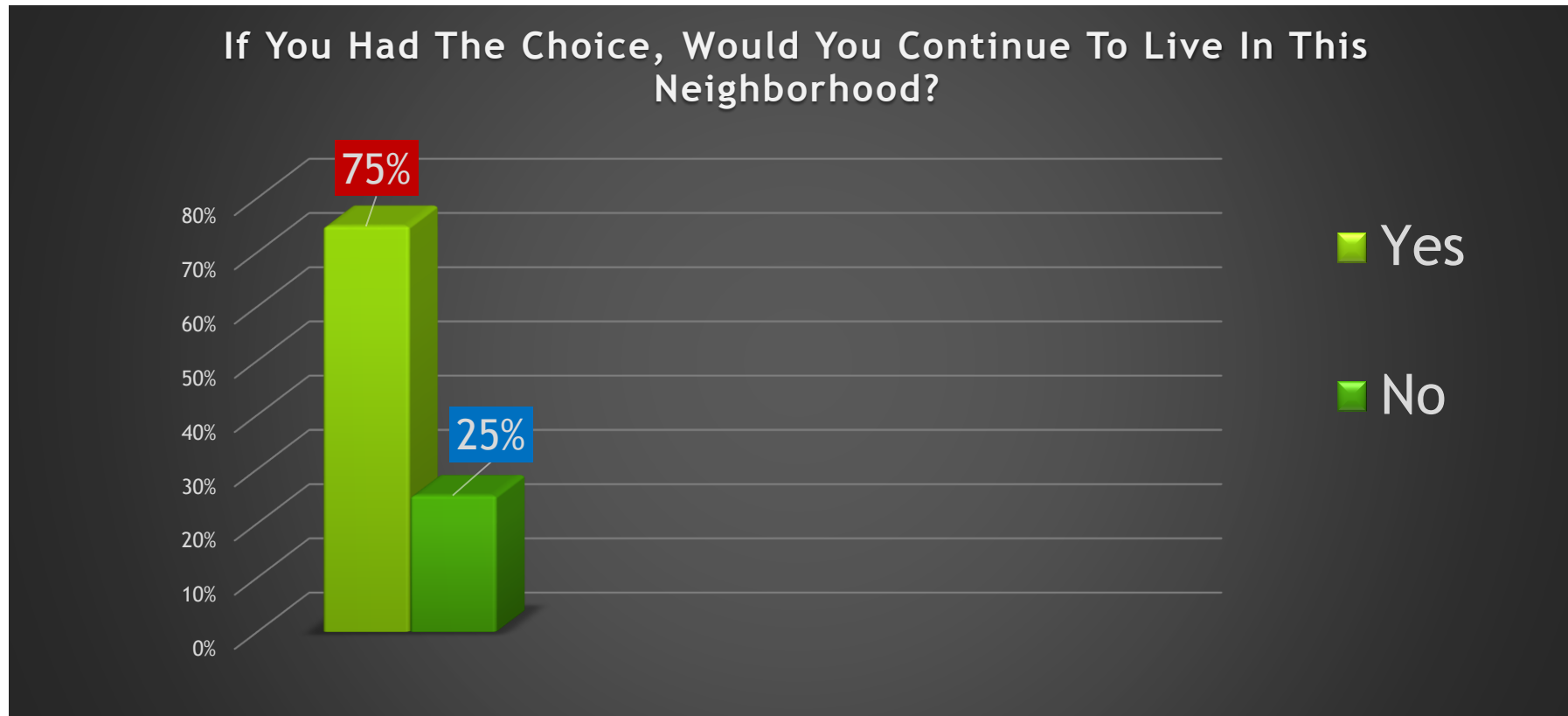
Growth in The Neighborhood



69% Of Residents Surveyed Are Either Satisfied Or Very Satisfied With The Neighborhood!

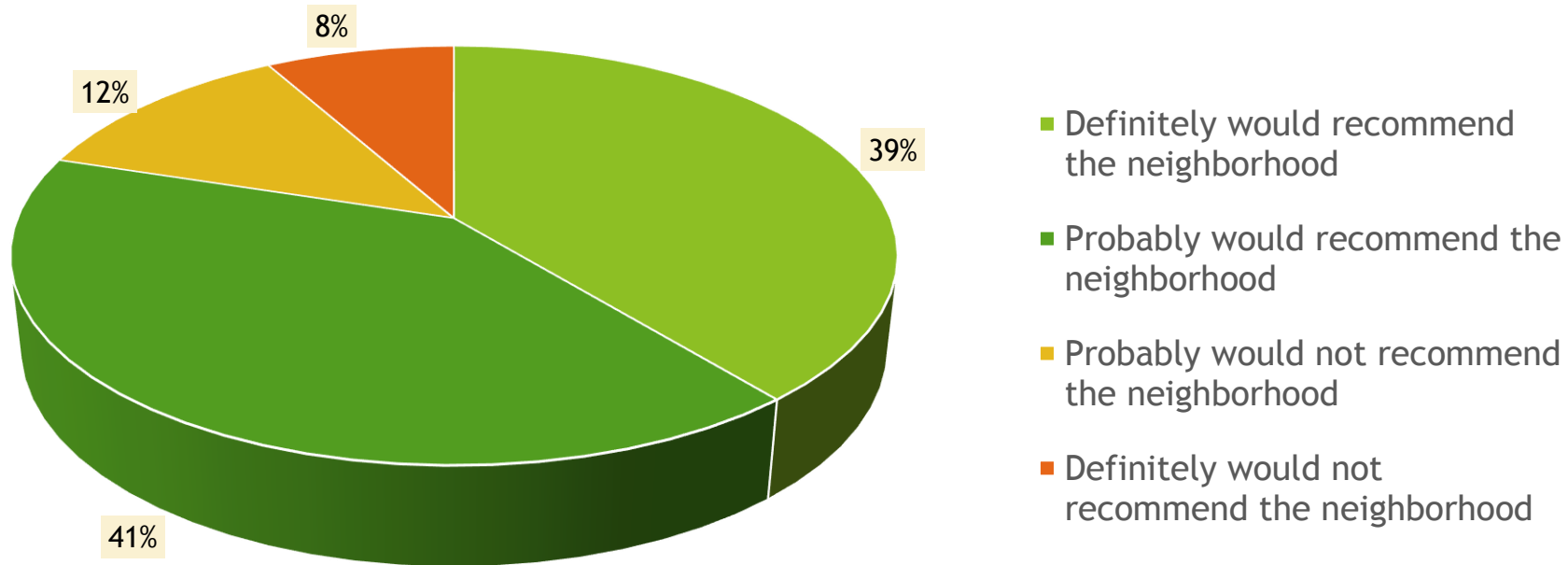


75% Of Residents Surveyed Would Continue To Live In Flowing Wells If Given The Choice!

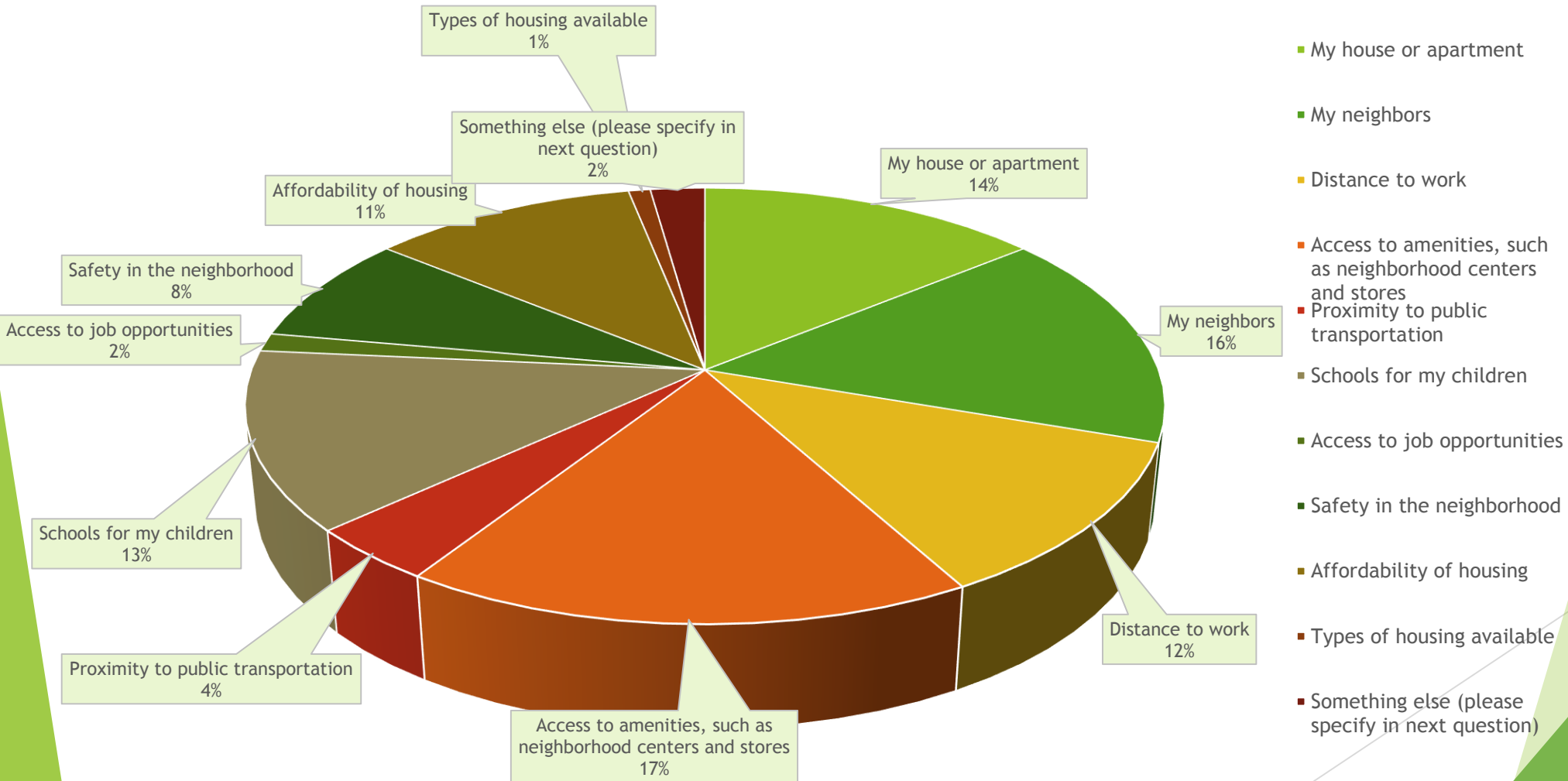


80% Of Residents Surveyed Either Probably Or Definitely Would Recommend Flowing Wells Neighborhood!

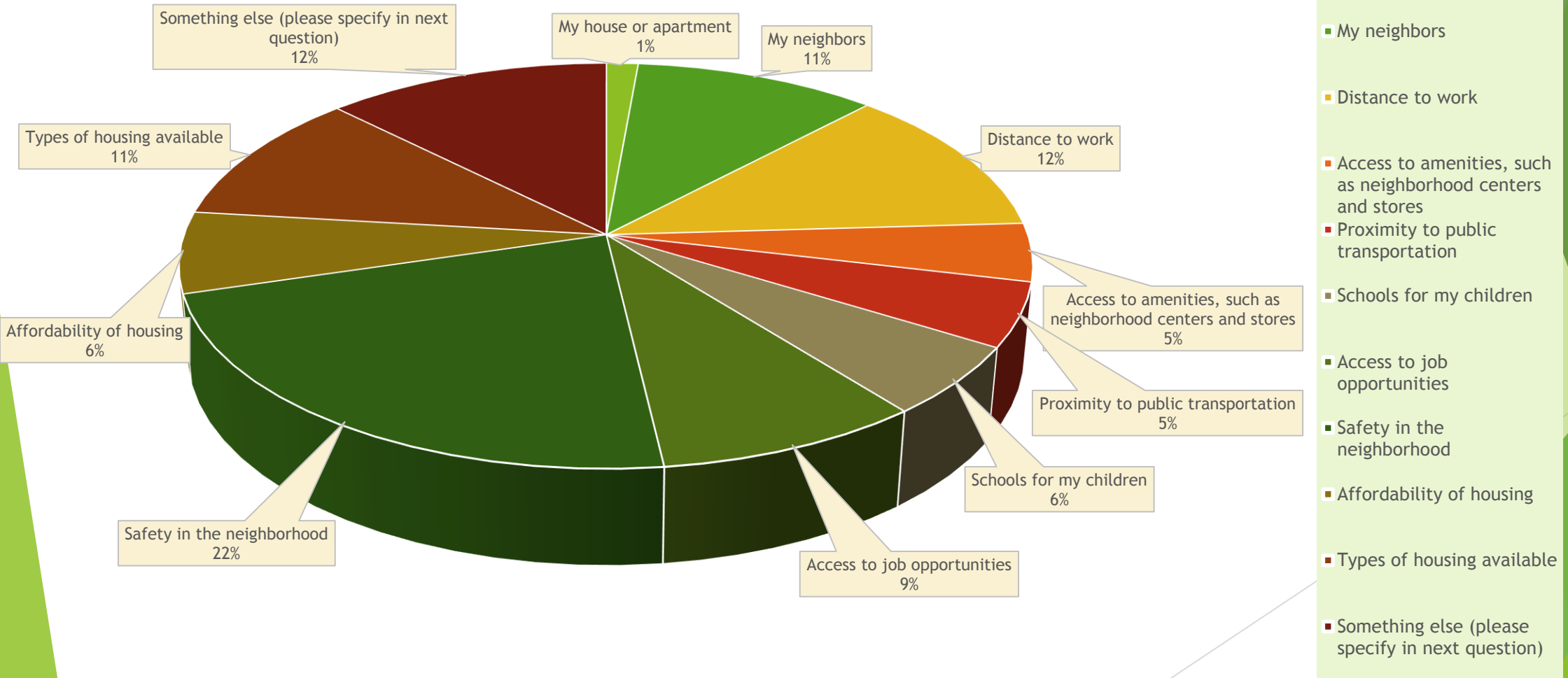
How Likely Residents Are To Recommend The Neighborhood



What Residents Like Best About Living In The Neighborhood.

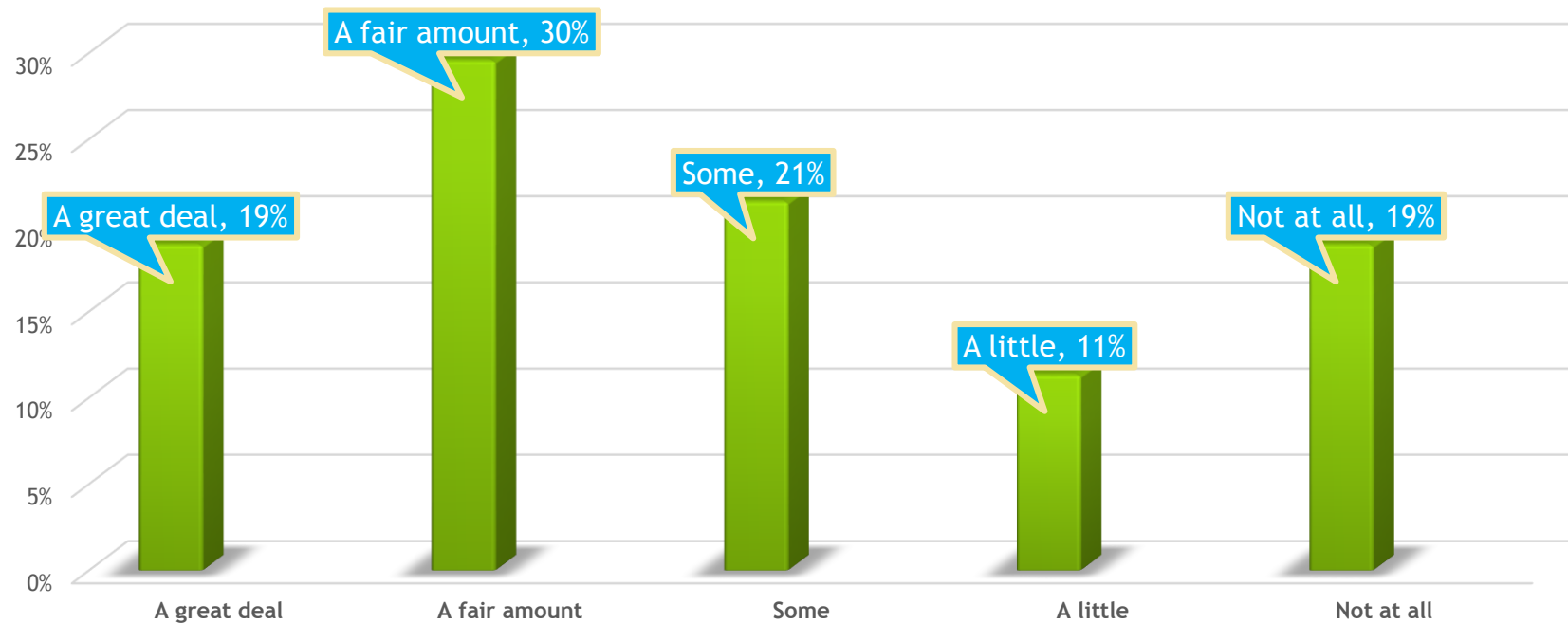


What Residents Like Least About Living In Flowing Wells.

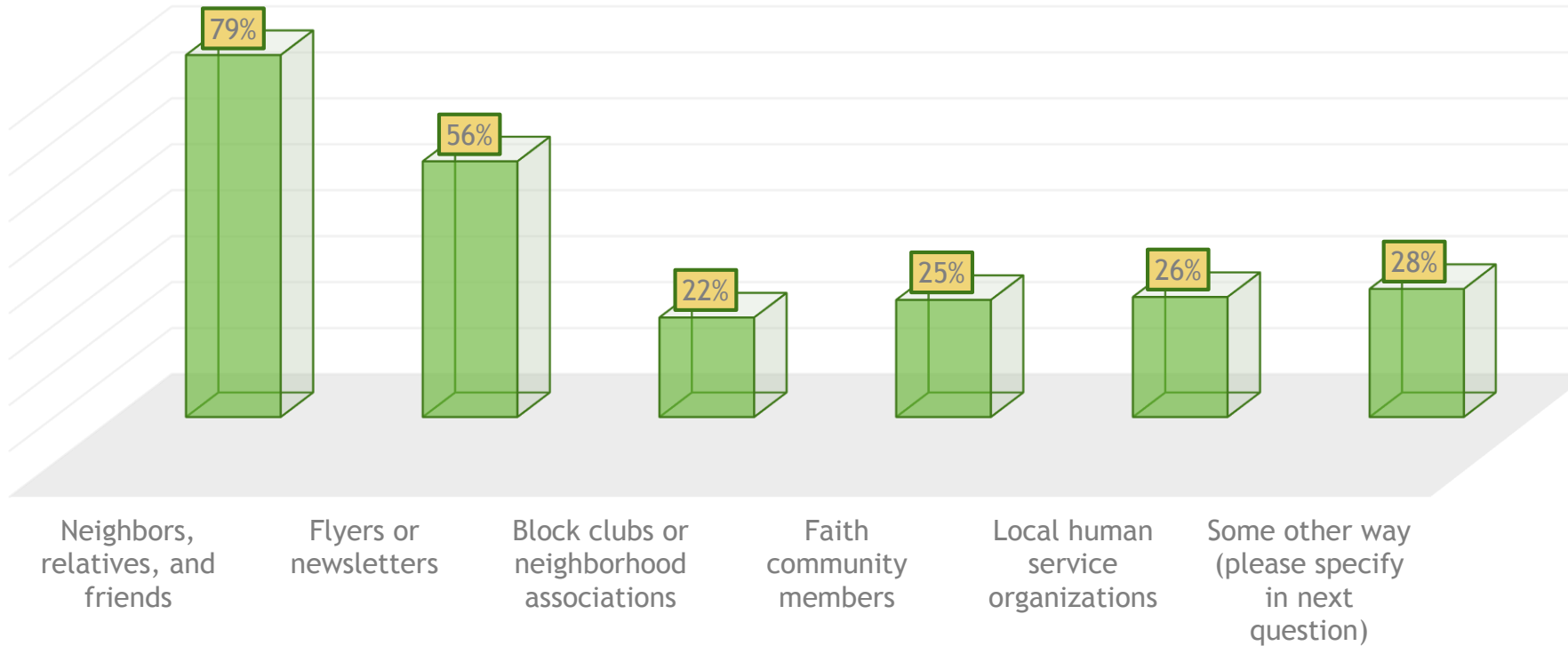


How Well Residents Feel Information About What Is Happening Locally Is Shared.

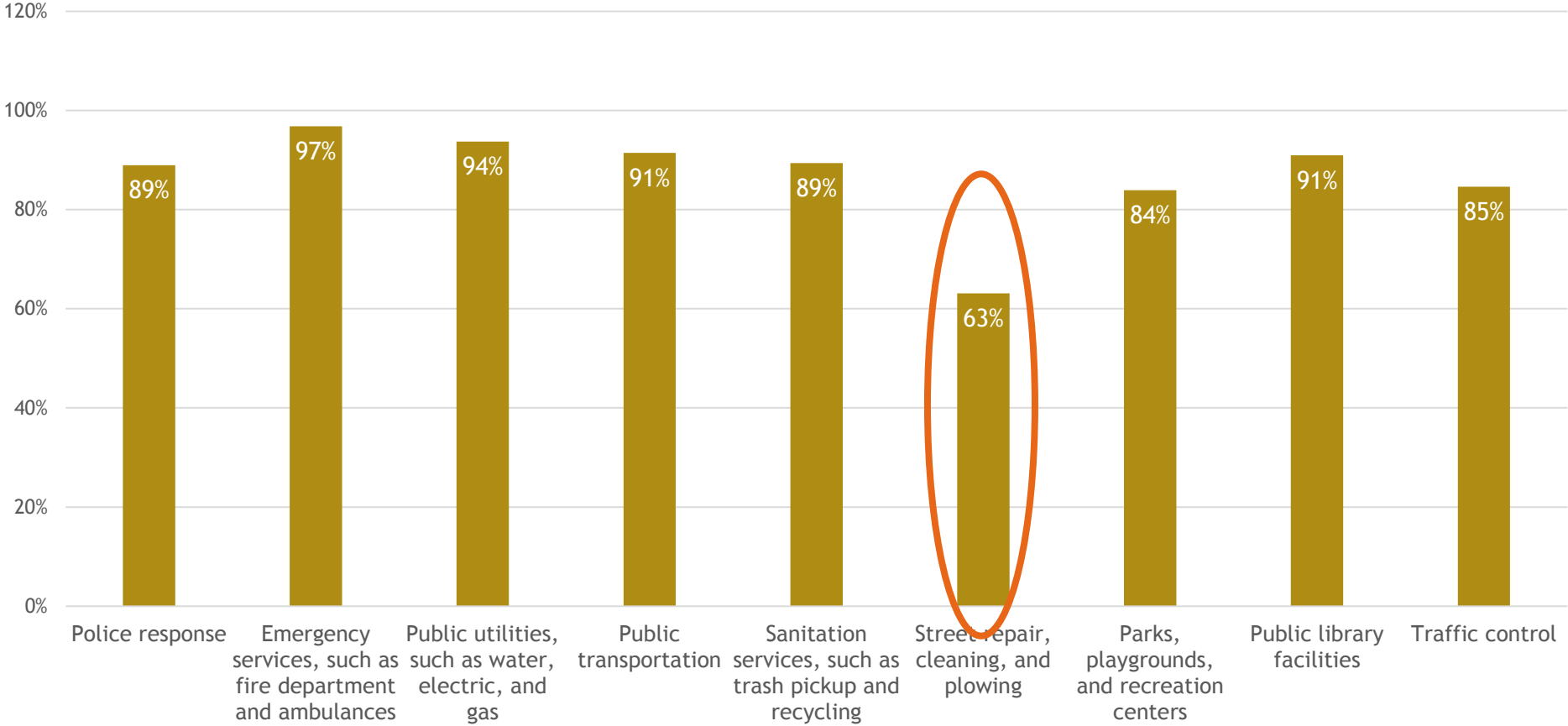
To what degree is information about local happenings shared?



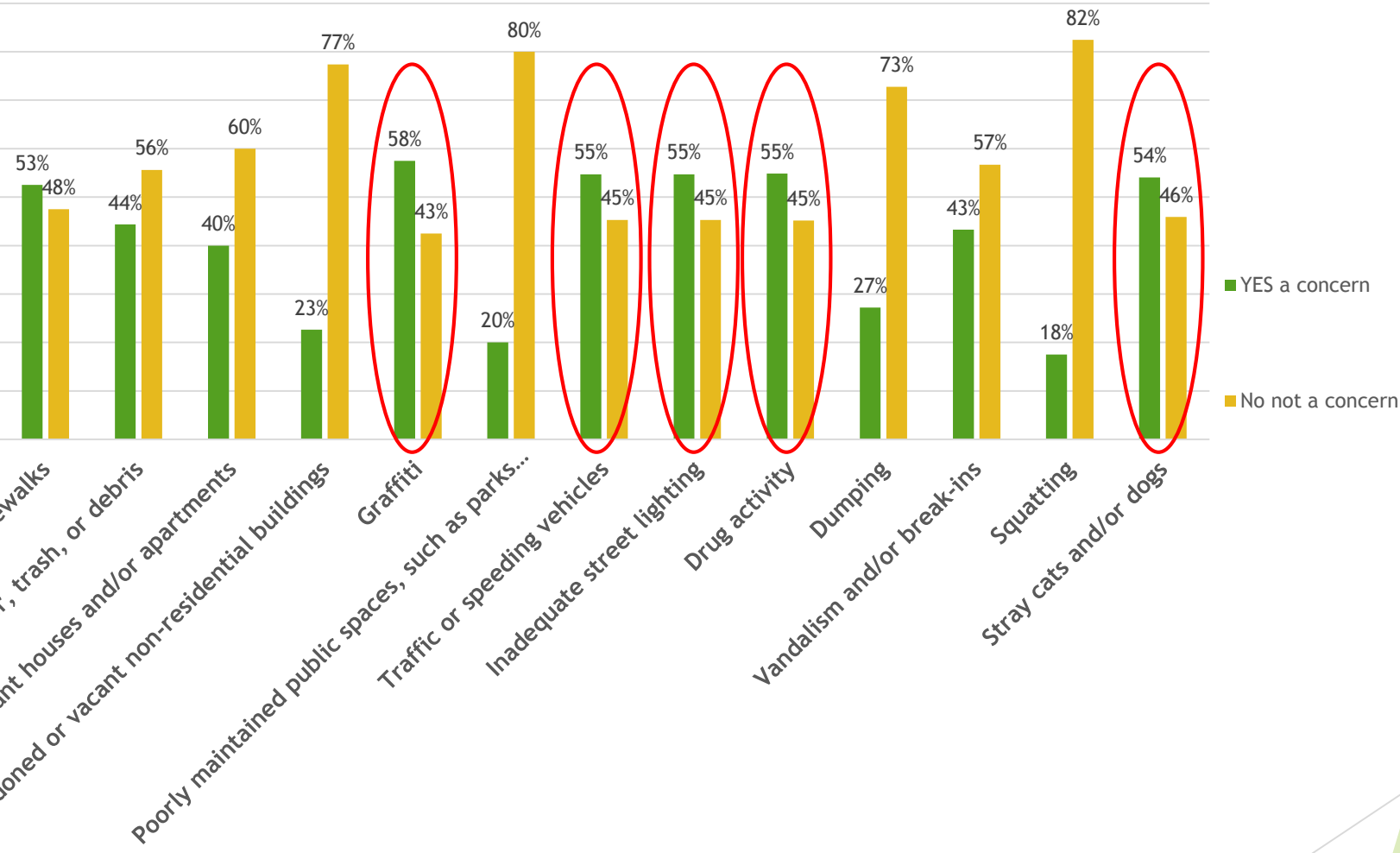
How Residents Learn About What Is Happening In The Neighborhood

Other Community Concerns Reported

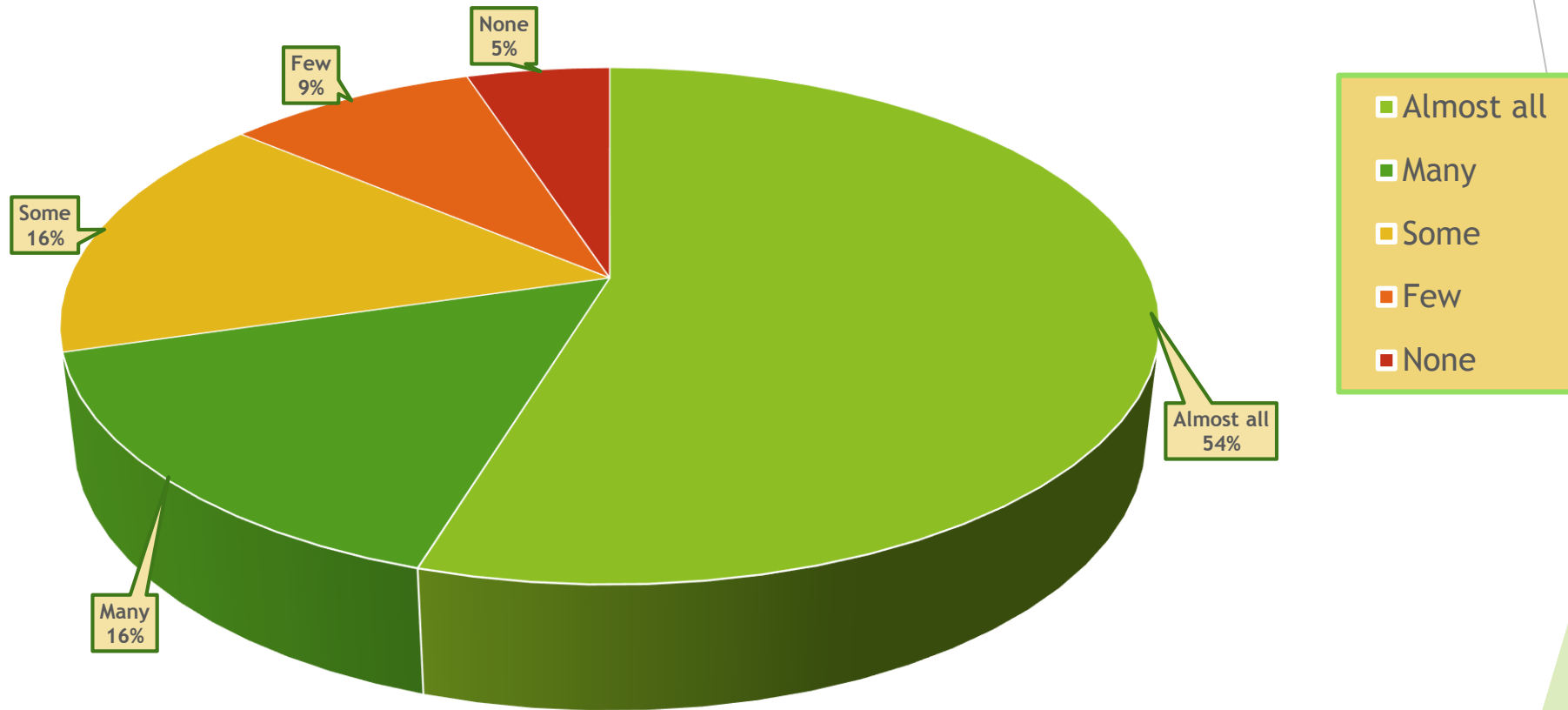
- ▶ Barking Dogs.

- ▶ do not have public spaces
- ▶ fast vehicles and motorcycles
- ▶ Kids walking around at night or during the day when they should be at school.
- ▶ kids with weapons
- ▶ neighbors are dirty
- ▶ people without garages
- ▶ stray cats and dogs are a big issue
- ▶ The graffiti is a big issue!
- ▶ They are repairing the sidewalks sometimes but this year they haven't yet, they have to pay themselves. Floods when it rains. Also fences falling over next to abandoned house (next door).
- ▶ Trailer park nearby is in bad shape
- ▶ Train is annoying! Also cant even get cops to come out here when you need them.
- ▶ weeds may catch fire, which is very dangerous

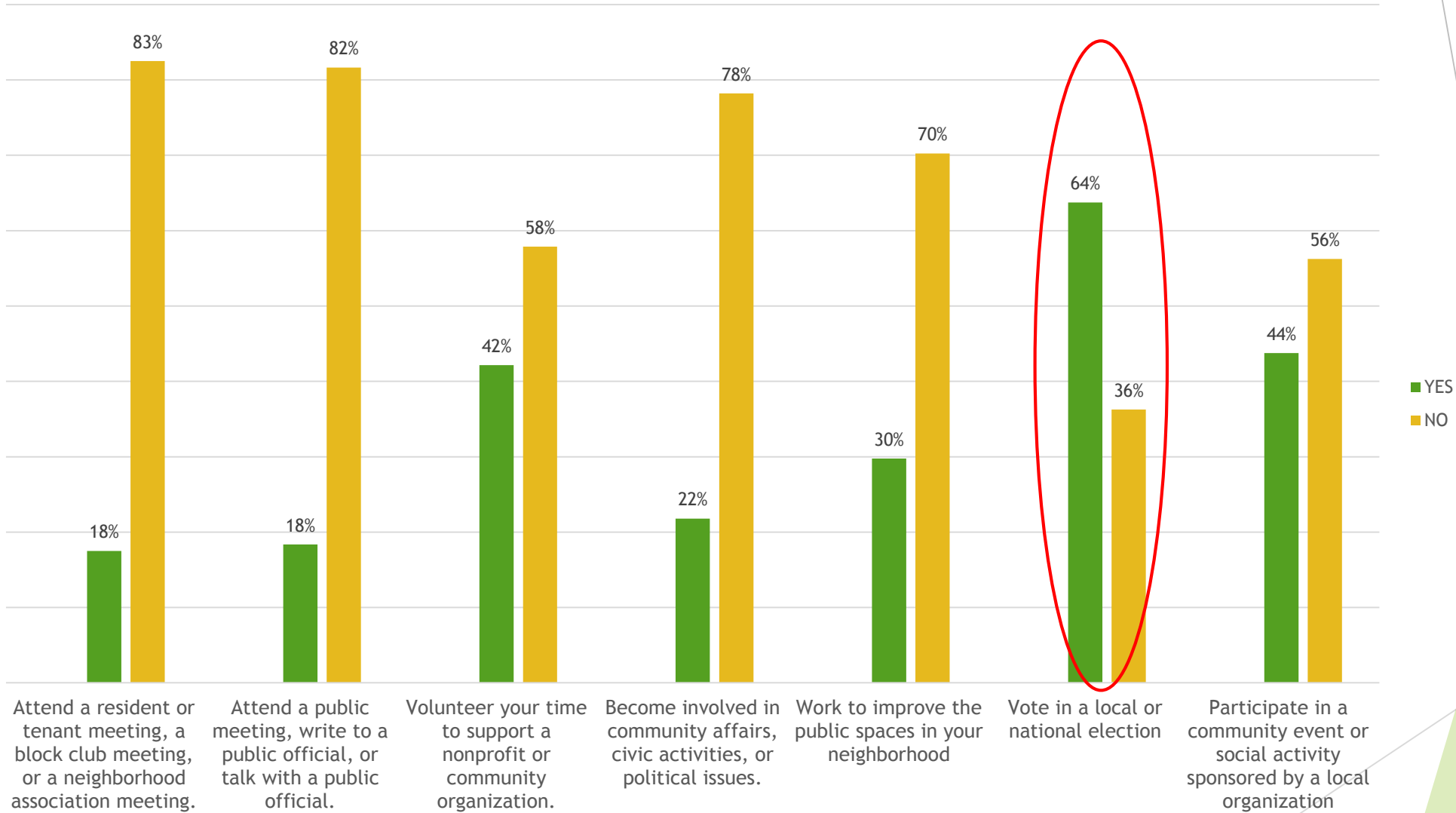

 - ▶ Graffiti,
 - ▶ Traffic and or Speeding Vehicles,
 - ▶ Drug Activity,
 - ▶ Inadequate Street Lighting &
 - ▶ Stray Cats and Dogs
