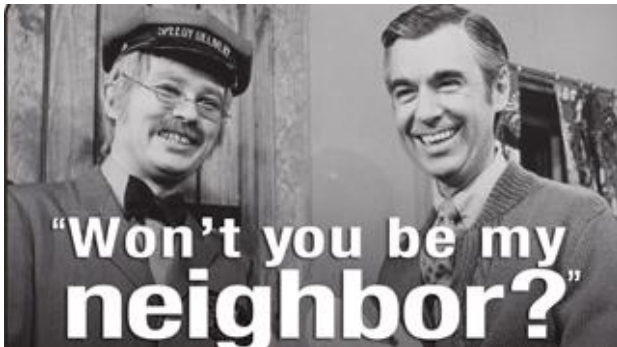
Volunteer Opportunities

We are pleased to announce Anthony Dambro will be handling the neighborhood snow removal.

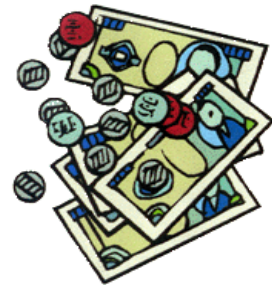


Ashbourne Hills Professionals Network
