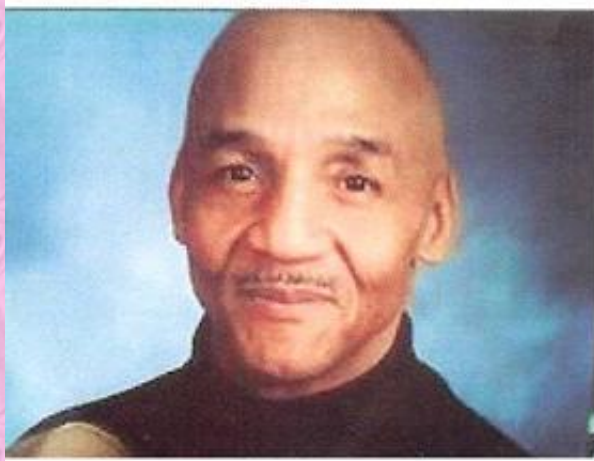

A SHARED PIECE OF HISTORY ON MORGAN PARK RESIDENTS

My grandparents built their home at 1243 W. 111th place in 1920 and my parents were married there November 30, 1922 and bought their new home at 10841 S. Bishop. My grandparents were William and Gertrude Bennett. My parents were Arthur S. and Gladys Pierce (no relation to Gorham Pierce).

My father was mayor of Morgan Park for 2 years. We had a Morgan Park week every year. While he was mayor, delegates from across the tracks requested that we on our side of the tracks change our name. East of the Rock Island railroad tracks was black and west of the tracks was white.

My sister Arthera M. Pierce was born in my grandmother's home and I was born at the University of Illinois Research hospital. My mother died in 1978 and my father in 1991. They moved from Morgan Park in 1960 or 61 when the Dan Ryan was built where our house was. I left M.P. in 1958 when I moved to Prairie Shores and then to Lake Meadows and I have been in Minneapolis, MN. since 1983.

Barbara Farnandis's oldest sister, Thelma, was a sponsor of a group of girls and boys, who had activities for us. Mrs. Maybelle was also a sponsor of our group at another time. Some of the people in the group were; Jimmie Jackson, August Sylvain, Joyce Moore, Walter Strickland, Wayne Smith, "Gump" Dixon, Donald Robbins, June Campbell and me. I can't remember the others. I think Josephine "Bunny" Columbel was in the group also.
