Montgomery Complex Update

On October 12, 2016 Albuquerque Public Schools gave a presentation of their planned project for the 12 acres on the corner of Louisiana and Comanche at the east end of the Mossman Neighborhood. The plan presented was for a modern teacher training center at the SE corner and a covered parking structure and solar panels. The site has now been cleared and proposals were accepted in February for building construction. Bradburry Stamm Construction was selected as the General Contractor. Because the proposals exceeded the bond allocation money, the project will be scaled back, eliminating the parking structure. APS plans to begin construction this summer.
