- 2. Working on drainage ditches to flow to the pumping station behind Belle Grove.

Mike Treague-Sheriff/Steve Guidry-Chief deputy/crime

- 1. They have been patrolling Old 51. Reported crimes are low in this area. Presented a statistics chart showing 75% of tickets written for speeding was issued to non-residents and 25% issued to residents.
- 2. There are about 100 cameras installed in the River Parishes. They are really helping out with solving crime cases.
- 3. Unlocked cars are being broken into mostly in the Parish. Advised everyone to lock your vehicle at all times.
- 4. Sheriff Treague has about 156 officers. He has 6 agents working with federal partners. Asked the parish to help out with social media by not putting any negative comments, but to call him first.
