

The following is the information on a survey that residents of our neighborhood may respond to if they are so inclined:

I am contacting you on behalf of a team from Yale's Jackson Institute that is conducting an independent research project in consultation with UNHCR, the United Nations' Refugee Agency. Led by Joseph Cassidy of the Wilson Center, we seek to study refugee resettlement in Denver and Aurora County, and provide advice to UNHCR and the U.S. Government about how to improve the U.S. refugee resettlement program.

Past research in this area has failed to effectively study the perspectives and thoughts of the community, and so we are reaching out to select Neighborhood Organizations in Denver with the goal of better understanding your perspectives and the perspective of your neighborhood. We've chosen the Country Club Historic Neighborhood because we believe your thoughts might be particularly enlightening on this issue.
