

## Member Event: Free Curbside Bulk Item Collection

## BENEFIT FOR MANOR LAKE CIVIC ASSOCIATION MEMBERS ONLY

## **April 14, 2018**

This event will be scheduled twice during the year with each MLCA member household eligible to **use the service free one time during the year (on either date)**. Members may participate a second time for the nominal fee of \$5.00. The first collection this year is scheduled for Saturday, April 14, 2018. The second collection will be held Saturday, October 13, 2018. This is a new date. In previous years it was in December.

**To Participate in the Curbside Bulk Item Collection**, make sure your dues for 2018 are paid and **sign up for the collection** by sending your name and street address, and your desired date, with the subject: Bulk Item Collection to Phyllis Taylor (email: <a href="mailto:ptmlboard@gmail.com">ptmlboard@gmail.com</a>) or call 301-460-5581. This is a **members' only** benefit. <a href="mailto:ptmlboard@gmail.com">NOTE: Paying your dues does NOT AUTOMATICALLY sign you up</a> for the bulk collection; **you MUST SIGN UP** for this service — it is not automatically done through your Manor Lake dues payment. Please use one of the above-referenced methods.

#### Details:

#### **Date**

- Saturday, April 14, 2018 Collection
  - Deadlines (but please don't wait): Sign-up by noon April 13, 2018.
    Join or renew membership online by April 12th,
    or if by US mail with membership form and check, it must be postmarked by April 9th.

#### Conditions

- Collection will begin at 9:30 AM on the designated day.
- Items must be placed at the end of the driveway or at the edge of the road for pickup by 9:00 AM in case the trucks are running early.
- Collection items must **NOT** include regular household trash.

# **Acceptable Items**

•	Furniture	•	Doors
•	Appliances	•	Mowers (MUST be drained of oil/gas)
•	Potted plants	•	Sinks/toilets/tubs
•	Televisions	•	Clothing items (preferably bagged or boxed)
•	Computer monitors or CPUs	•	Car batteries
•	Other electronic devices	•	Carpeting (cut into manageable pieces &
•	Mattresses		rolled up)

## **Unacceptable Items**

- Tires
- Liquid paint (cans must be opened and dried out with sawdust or kitty litter)
- Any item containing gasoline, oil, or antifreeze
- Dead animal carcasses
- Human or medical waste

This is a benefit for Manor Lake Civic Association members ONLY; member households may use this service for free only one time (either date) during the membership year (2<sup>nd</sup> time for \$5).
