

FROM THE CLAY COUNTY CONSTITUTION COMMITTEE:

Each of the three Clay County Commissioners appointed four people to a committee to hear what our residents want in the way of a county government. The committee has scheduled eight meetings across the county seeking input. At our organizational meeting the committee selected a lawyer as the chair and told the county lawyers they were no longer needed. The goal is to be transparent and at virtually no cost to the county. This group will not write a new constitution, only get information that will be handed over to a charter committee, appointed by our Circuit Judges, if the residents vote April 7, 2020 to have this committee formed. The judge-appointed committee will draft a constitution and the residents of Clay County will vote on November 3, 2020 to see if we want a new government.
