



## Member Event: Free Curbside Bulk Item Collection

### 2020 BENEFIT FOR MANOR LAKE CIVIC ASSOCIATION MEMBERS ONLY

This event will be scheduled twice during this calendar year, with each MLCA member household eligible to **use the service one time free during the calendar year**. The first collection is scheduled for April 25, 2020 – just in time for spring cleaning. The second pick-up of the year will be October 10, 2020 – just in time to clear out your home to make room for holiday parties and guests.

If you would like to participate in the Curbside Bulk Item Collection, make sure your 2020 dues are paid and sign-up for the collection by sending an email with your name, phone number and your preferred participation date, with the **Subject: Bulk Item Collection**, followed by your **house number** and **street name**, to Don Seifert (email: Don@ManorLake.org). You **MUST SIGN-UP VIA EMAIL**. There is **NO SIGN-UP BY PHONE**. If you wish to participate a second time during the calendar year, you may do so for the nominal fee of \$5.00. You may [pay it online](#) or send a check to the address below.

**NOTE:** Paying your dues or \$5.00 does not automatically sign you up. You must sign-up by email as mentioned above.

#### Dates

- Saturday, April 25, 2020
  - Deadline: join or renew and sign-up by April 22 (checks should be postmarked by April 16 in order to be received in time).
- Saturday, October 10, 2020
  - Deadline: sign up by October 7 (checks should be postmarked by October 1 in order to be received in time) to be included in the October 10 pick-up event.

#### Conditions

- Collection will begin a little after 9:00 AM on the designated day.
- Items must be placed at the end of the driveway or at the edge of the road **by 9:00 AM** for pickup.
- Collection items must **NOT** include regular household trash or construction debris.

#### Acceptable Items

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Appliances</li><li>• Potted plants</li><li>• Televisions</li><li>• Computer monitors or CPUs</li><li>• Mattresses</li><li>• Car batteries</li><li>• Carpeting (cut into manageable pieces &amp; rolled up)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mowers (<b>MUST be drained of oil/gas</b>)</li><li>• Small gas-powered tools (<b>MUST be drained of oil/gas</b>)</li><li>• Doors</li><li>• Sinks/toilets/tubs</li><li>• Paint cans <b>IF</b> they are opened and <b>dried out</b> with sawdust or kitty litter</li><li>• Furniture</li></ul>

#### Unacceptable Items

- Household trash
- Clothing/bedding
- Tires
- Liquid paint (cans acceptable but must be opened and dried out with sawdust or kitty litter)
- Any item containing gasoline, oil, or antifreeze
- Dead animal carcasses
- Human or medical waste

This is a benefit for Manor Lake Civic Association **members ONLY**; member households may use this service **only one time during the calendar year for free**; second time incurs a nominal \$5.00 fee.
