



ANDREW JACKSON YOUNG JR.



- Was born on March 12 1932, and he is now 88-year old.
- **Pastor** of Bethany Congregational Church, Thomasville, Georgia, 1955.
- Closed confidant of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.
- Helped END white-minority rule in Namibia and Zimbabwe
- Withdrew U.S. support for Portugal in Portugal's effort to keep its African Colonies.
- The Atlanta Highway System (75?).
- Secured U.S. funds for the African Development Bank (Banque Africaine de Devéloppement).

THE AFRICAN DEVELOPMENT BANK





Banque Africaine de Devéloppement

Funs secured by Andrew Young in the U.S. Congress. **U.S. Congressional capital** founded the Bank in **1964**.

The bank is a multilateral development finance institution comprising three entities:

- a) The African Development Bank;
- b) The African Development **FUND**, and
- c) The Nigeria Trust **FUND**.

Now, the bank includes the Antilles (Caribbean), Bermuda and Jamaica. Today it has 90 nation members.

THE AFRICAN DEVELOPMENT BANK GOALS

Abidjan, Côte d'Ivoire

- Be the premier development finance institution on the African continent.
- Help reduce poverty, improve living conditions for Africans, (and to) mobilize resources for the continent's economic and social development.

BL&CK B&NKS

- First black owned bank was founded by Reverend (Pastor) William Washington, Virginia, 1888/1889.
- First commercial Black owned bank in the West was founded by Onie B. Granville, LA, CA, 1961/1964. The bank helped brake the chokehold of Redlining in CA (mainly LA) and throughout its operating area CA and west of Kansas City, Missouri.

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND

When Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. was assassinated on April 4, 1968, he had just launch the "Poor People's" Movement (economic justice) which quickly fizzled after that this death.

(March on Washington D. C, June 24, 1968, Southern **CHRISTIAN** Leadership Conference, lead by **Ralph Abernethy**, a **Baptist Minister**)

With this historic backdrop, the AME church has announced an innovative economic partnership with 19 blackowned banks across the country.

This partnership aims to be a catalyst to spur business development, homeownership and wealth in the black community, and to strengthen black banks and their capacity to lend to small businesses, to secure mortgages, to provide personal lines of credit, and to offer other forms of credit to AME churches and our members.

This of course, included enabling members and their families to become homeowners.

THE INITIATIVE GOALS

- Increase deposits and loans with black banks.
- Increase black homeownership to over 50% nationwide. This means 2 million more black homeowners than now exist.
- Grow the number of black businesses from 2.6 million to **4 million**, and total receipts from an average of \$72,500 to **\$150,000**.
- Follow the "Black Wealth 2020" Initiative.



- Community (Biology): "An interacting group of various species in a COMMON environment or location.
- Common Property (Ownership): "Fully owned by two or more people v. Personal Property."

- Short-term Goal: Church/Banks
 Economic Initiative(s)
- Long Term: Church Investment Fund(s).

ROCHELLE 2022 INITIATIVE.

LOCAL BANKS AND CHURCHES

(Two-year growth projection)

- Mission: to reduce POVERTY and improve LIVING conditions (employment/small business and housing).
 - Work with the Church(es) to create an investment fund.
 - Increase the number of deposits and loans.
 - Increase the number of (Black/White) Homeownership (mortgage loans),
 - Increase Black business and small business lending by a %.
 - Increase the number of Automobile loans by a %.
 - Increase Personal Lines of Credit.
 - Dedicated effort to STOP the perceived redlining of District 2, and the bias and segregation, by skin-tone, and socioeconomics of District 1.

LET US ÆGREE TO COME BÆCK

- As a group in 60 days (PRESS conference).
- Commit to meeting with the Pastors the 3rd Sunday of February 2020.
- 30 days for the banks to work their numbers (individually or as a group).
- 60 days for the Church(es) with the result of a feasibility study and their numbers.
- I am extremely willing to meet with the Pastors and Administrators in common with a presentation about program development at any time.
