

Telico Trails Lot Owners' Association Lake and Fishing Privileges

Lake privileges (boating, fishing, swimming) are available only to Telico Trails lot owners and renters who have paid their annual dues and nonresident paid guest members. No one else has lake privileges. The rules apply to Telico, Spring, Lost, and Hickory Lakes. Specific rules are as follows:

1. The fish limit is as per State of Arkansas Law.
2. Jug, limb, trotline, yo-yo, noodle fishing and fishing with gill nets is prohibited. Recreational fishing only is allowed. This prevents the lakes from being overfished and aids in keeping the aesthetic beauty of the lakes enjoyed by all.
3. All fishermen ages 16 and over must have a valid Arkansas State Fishing License.
4. Telico Trails Lot Owners' Association Members may extend fishing privileges to guests, but only when the member or a member of his/her household is present. Member is responsible for actions/conduct of guests.
5. All members must have their membership card present when on the lakes. Membership cards can be acquired by all persons having paid their annual dues by contacting board member person listed on the website. Membership is available to lot owners, property renters, and approved non-resident guests (no more than 12 guest memberships will be issued/year in order to prevent overfishing of lakes).
6. Only 10 horsepower motors or less may be used on the lakes.
7. Sailboats, paddleboats, canoes, and kayaks are allowed on the lakes. No jet skis are allowed.
8. No vehicle parking on the roadways or levees/dams. All 4 wheels of a vehicle must be off the road.
9. Leaves and other debris are not to be dumped or blown into the lakes.
10. It is against the law to release contaminants into Telico Trails Lakes. Incidents will be reported to the Environmental Protection Agency.
11. All members are asked to help with enforcement of lake/fishing rules and regulations. Anyone who is using the lakes without a permit will be asked to leave. If said person refuses to leave, local law enforcement will be called.
12. Anyone using lake or common areas is expected to carry out any trash or waste – please help keep areas clean by not littering.
