The Coordinated Entry to Shelter hotline is the centralized system for people experiencing or at risk of homelessness to access Baltimore City-funded emergency shelters. The system is designed to provide a fast, streamlined, and equitable process to enroll at participating emergency shelters and preserve client choice and dignity. Everyone in Baltimore City seeking entry to a City-funded shelter must go through the hotline.
