RECYCLING RESTART FAQs



WHAT DAY IS MY RECYCLING?

To find out your recycling collection day, please visit the map linked above!

CAN MY RECYCLING BE IN A PLASTIC BAG?

No. Recycling that is collected in a plastic bag will be placed in the trash. Any *labeled* container is an accepted container in Baltimore!

Ex: Old trash can, storage tote, cardboard boxes and paper bags

WHEN IS BULK TRASH PICKUP STARTING AGAIN?

There is no scheduled date at this time. Bulk trash drivers are still being utilized for trash and recycling collections.

WHAT IF MY TRASH ISN'T PICKED UP?

If your trash or recycling collection is ever missed, please call 311. Your Service Request will be sent directly to the supervisor and will be resolved within 24 hours.

WHAT CAN I RECYCLE?

Plastic bottles, jars, and jugs, paper, cardboard, aluminum and steel cans, cartons, glass bottles and jars.

When in doubt, throw it out!

WHAT DAYS ARE THE COMMUNITY RECYCLING CENTERS OPEN?

Open Wednesdays and Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.
Effective March 1, all of the Community Collection Centers will be discontinued.

WHAT DAYS ARE CITIZENS' CONVENIENCE CENTERS OPEN?

Monday- Saturday, 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
