<u>Old business</u>: Wall repairs, Metzger completed repairs to questioned areas, but stair-stepping is still occurring – question is whether properly repaired, but project is complete. The Board discussed the need to take & catalog the "after" pictures for future enforcement actions.

- -- AYR has replaced the damaged plants at the front monument, still an open question as to those behind lots 10 & 37. TCPM to address with AYR.
- -- Tree planting on southern walk-way continue to table until fall, anticipate price difference, Board concern still on attention to detail by the crews

Architectural: no actions pending

New business: The Board discussed the past amendment of the CC&Rs that impacted the landscaping standards for front yards. There is the recollection that an amendment that reduced the number of large trees was implemented. The concern is formalizing any changes in light of newer xeriscape approaches & desert landscaping. TCPM to research whether amendment was formalized. TABLE

-- Bees have been seen around some of the water valve boxes, the concern is whether this is a temporary or long-term matter. Cost estimate for AYR vs. TCPM contractor about \$150 each. Motion to request AYR treatment if bees are still present at their next scheduled visit, APPROVED unanimously (R. Palmatier motion, R. Thomas second)

-- Officer positions for the upcoming year, all willing to continue in same function; J. Davila still willing to post notices to Facebook page
