

## North Long Beach District 9 Artesia Boulevard Renovation Plans

The Artesia improvement project consists of a complete reimagining of the corridor featuring new wayfinding signage, parklets, protected bikeways, safer crosswalks and efforts to create a safer environment for pedestrians, cyclists and motorists.



Some of the key safety

features are 12 upgraded traffic signals and dedicated turn signals at certain intersections. The project also includes installing fiber optic cable that will allow for closed circuit television cameras that connect to the traffic control headquarters in Downtown Long Beach.

#### NEED HELP WITH RENTAL ASSISTANCE?

#### **Long Beach Reopens Emergency Rental Assistance Program**

The City has reopened the Long Beach Emergency Rental Assistance Program (LB-ERAP) for qualified landlords and tenants to apply for pandemic-related rental assistance. The reopening of the program is due to an additional \$13.1 million the City has recently received in state and federal funding, bringing the program budget up to \$64 million.

All LB-ERAP applications can be submitted via the program's online information and service portal available on the <u>LB-ERAP webpage</u>, which also provides details about the program's various income and eligibility guidelines. People seeking to apply, as well as those with incomplete or pending applications, may contact the support line, hosted by Yardi Systems, the City's program partner, at 833.358.5372 for assistance from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Mondays through Fridays.
